No president had been married while in office and his marriage to the 24 year old Julia aroused much public interest. She was a Northerner but gave hen alle iance to the South. Her, loyalty deepened as the feeling between the Mortr and South deepened. used to have the Marine X band play at the White House and introduced "Hail to the Chief" as the presidential theme

song. She presided over the White House for 8 months and then they retired to his Virginia plantation,

Sherwood Forest.
