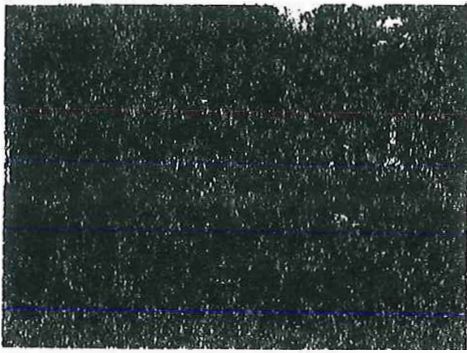

Monument Restoration – Glenwood contains a priceless collection of Victorian-era monuments and statuary, many of them well over 100 years old. Over time, Houston's soil causes monuments, statuary and copings to sink, and those displaced by tree roots must be repaired and stabilized. In many cases there are no longer any living descendants to take responsibility for needed repairs, and GCHPF must provide for the restoration and preservation of historic gravesites. Approximately \$200,000 is needed each year to fund monument restoration work.

Publication of Glenwood's History – A book is being prepared on the history of Glenwood Cemetery and some of the persons buried here. GCHPF is working to raise the estimated \$100,000 cost of publication. Proceeds from sales of the book will be used to fund the projects of GCHPF. A web site is also under construction at an estimated cost of \$3,500

Columbarium – Construction of an outdoor columbarium would position Glenwood to respond to the increased demand for ash burials.
