

FAVORITES WIN HANDILY IN COUNTY

'SPEED' MARTIN AND FOELSCHOW IN HEADLINER

Favorites came through without a startling upset yesterday in the first round of match play in the annual San Diego County amateur championship golf tournament at the Rancho Santa Fe Country club. Dr. G. W. Foelschow, medalist, with a new record 70, E. G. "Speed" Martin, Harvey D. Stalnaker, Bud Post and Jim McGregor, all advanced to the second round.

Two matches are on schedule today for all golfers, the first this morning and the semi-finals this afternoon. Finals in all flights, with the championship division playing 36 holes, will be staged tomorrow along with the Consolation which is open to all defeated players. Awards will be made in this competition for low gross and low net for the 18-hole medal round.

FOELSCHOW, MARTIN MEET

Dr. Foelschow continued his fine golf of the qualifying round to score victory by the largest margin yesterday, 6 and 5. Harry Hargreaves, youthful golfer, put up a gallant fight against Foelschow but still lacks tournament experience. Foelschow faces E. G. "Speed" Martin today in the second round.

Three golfers of the San Diego Country club, a trio from Coronado, one from the host club and one Balboa Park player, Del Urich, remained in the running after the first match yesterday. Foelschow, Stalnaker and Bud Post are the trio from Chula Vista, Larry Staley, Speed Martin and Jim McGregor hail from Coronado and Shaw Lovett from Rancho Santa Fe.

Barton Millard, 18-handicap player from Rancho Santa Fe put up the surprise match of the day. Though playing without the aid of his handicap, Millard held Staley, a six-handicap player, to a 3 and 1 score.
