



*Designed by local architect Lilian Rice in her trademark Spanish Mediterranean style, La Morada was first a guesthouse for Santa Fe Railway officials, featuring broad terraces, open fireplaces and sweeping vistas of the mountains to the northeast. Later open to the public by the Santa Fe Land Development Company and renamed "The Inn," it offered lodging and hospitality to prospective property buyers. The original wall seen in this photo (circa 1928) still marks the entrance to what is now The Inn at Rancho Santa Fe.*
