Berkeley, taught at several local schools, served as an architectural draftsman under Regua and Jackson; designed Rancho Santa Fe homes and shops in 1920's. Samuel Hamill was a student of hers during this project. Other works included the ZLAC Rowing Club, San Dieguito High School and Sweetwater Valley elementary school. She died in 1938 at the age of 49.
