The Cardiff Chamber of Commerce very kindly telephoned us today that you were looking for a golfing vacation in this area and would like to have our current brochures and rates. We are five miles inland and, therefore, enjoy somewhat more reliable weather than on the coast -- often having sunshine here when there is fog along the ocean. But, we are still close enough to have you enjoy the beach and ocean during the day if that is what you desire. We have a beach cottage at Del Mar for the use of our guests, away from the more crowded general beach area.

I believe you would find The Inn to be a delightful, small, personal hotel in a beautiful setting. We have attractive accommodations mostly in cottages, two restaurants and a cocktail lounge in the main building (pictured above) and fine recreational facilities, including swimming, tennis and putting green on the grounds. For golfing we have three fine 18-hole country club courses where guests may play. Green fees range from \$7-\$17.00 depending upon the course and the day of the week. Golf Carts are available for \$9-\$10.00.

The Inn is adjacent to the village of Rancho Santa Fe with its variety of small shops and art galleries and is within an area of interesting sightseeing in northern San Diego County - the Wild Animal Park at San Pasqual, the world famous San Diego Zoo, Sea World, scenic La Jolla and colorful Mexico within a pleasant drive.

For guests arriving by air, we provide a limousine service to and from the San Diego Airport for the current charge of \$7.50 per person for the 25 mile trip. For this we need to know the airlines schedules a couple days in advance.



Lomas Santa Fe, about four miles away, is a beautiful rolling course also and for those who enjoy the "nine" they offer a challenging Executive golf course. Whispering Palms Country Club, approximately two miles, is situated in the valley and is the flattest of the courses, but nevertheless challenging enough to have the Ladies P.G.A. held there every Fall.
