## GENERAL INFORMATION

### RANCHO SANTA FE

once a vast Mexican land grant, is now an attractive American community of charming early California-Spanish atmosphere. Its rolling hills, its stately eucalyptus trees afford a magnificent setting for THE INN. Rancho Santa Fe is 105 miles south of Los Angeles, and 27 miles north of San Diego, via San Diego Freeway #5, and five miles inland from Solana Beach or Del Mar. When coming on Freeway #5 from the north use either the Encinitas Blvd. or Lomas Santa Fe off ramp—from the south use Via De La Valle off ramp.

### THE INN

accommodates...guests in large and attractively furnished rooms. All accommodations have private baths, all are comfortably heated and many have wood-burning fireplaces. THE INN caters to a select clientele and reserves the right to request references.

### CLIMATE

In summer, the average maximum is 79 degrees—rarely exceeding 90 degrees—and the winters are just as kind, with an average minimum of 45 degrees. The difference between the averages of the coolest and of the hottest months of the year is 17 degrees.

### SMOG FREE

A recent article in the Wall Street Journal mentioned 2 locations in Southern California as smog free, one of which is Rancho Santa Fe.

### GOLF

The Rancho Santa Fe championship 18 hole golf course is skillfully laid out and kept in excellent condition the year round. Within easy walking distance, it is open to guests of THE INN, with green fees comparable to those charged on other first class golf courses. Also within 10 minutes drive of the hotel are two other excellent golf courses on which Inn guests are invited to play. Electric carts are available.

### SWIMMING

A heated, filtered swimming pool on THE INN grounds is flanked by an outdoor terrace, where luncheon service is available during the summer season.

### BEACH COTTAGE

THE INN offers a cottage for guests at nearby Del Mar Beach between June 15th and September 15. Showers, dressing rooms and lockers are available together with complete beach equipment. Box lunches available by ordering night previous or early AM of day desired.

### RECREATION

Bowling greens, Tennis, Badminton and Shuffle board are included among the recreational facilities which are offered guests at THE INN.

### RIDING

Horses may be obtained from near-by stables by the day or hour.

### LIBRARY

THE INN provides a 4000 book Library, set up in casual style, located within THE INN, but set apart for quiet relaxation and enjoyment.

### CHILDREN

Baby sitters are available on request.

### DOGS & OTHER PETS

are permitted in cottage rooms only with a charge of \$2.00 per day. Charge does not include food.

### SIGHT SEEING

Rancho Santa Fe is the center of an area filled with interesting and beautiful sights. Colorful Mexico is close at hand, as well as many of the old Spanish Missions, Palomar Observatory, Scripps Institute of Oceanography at La Jolla, Sea World and San Diego Zoo.

### WHAT TO WEAR

Sport clothes prevail at Rancho Santa Fe. Remember the nights are cool and stimulating. Wearing of coats and tie by men is suggested in the dining room at dinner.

### GARDEN ROOM

The main dining room overlooks the pool and acres of lawn and gardens. Serves breakfast, luncheon and dinner. Air conditioned.

### VINTAGE ROOM

An early California setting for cocktails with dancing on the Terrace in season. Serves luncheon and dinner specialties. Air-conditioned.

### MEAL RATES

Breakfast a la carte — Luncheon from \$2.50, Dinner from \$4.00.

### MEETING HOUSE

The conference building, acclaimed as one of the most versatile and efficient meeting places in the country, is available for groups which require guests rooms and is available at all times for conferences, exhibits, meetings, luncheons, dinners and other private functions that do not require guest rooms. The main conference room seats 225 for meetings, movies or stage presentations and may be divided into two or three smaller rooms, each equipped with its own audio and visual aids. Other features include a special kitchen and serving bar; scientific lighting and acoustics and an experienced conference manager to assist you with details. Also air conditioned.

### CATALPA COTTAGE

A small fully equipped conference room for small group meetings for 35-40 persons. Sliding doors lead to a sun terrace which may be used for coffee breaks and leg stretching recesses. This accommodation is air-conditioned and has a special snack and serving bar arrangement and own private lavatory. Props and equipment essential for meetings are included in this facility.

<b>VIA AIR</b>	Deplane at Lindbergh Field, San Diego
<b>VIA AUTOMOBILE</b>	U.S. Highway Interstate 5 to Solana Beach, turning east at Loma Santa Fe for five miles direct to Rancho Santa Fe. The Management will be glad, upon application, to arrange for a rented car upon arrival, or for the delivery of rented cars to guests, who may wish to drive from Los Angeles or San Diego. Our Station Wagons will meet trains, planes or buses at \$2.75 per person when arrangements are made in advance.

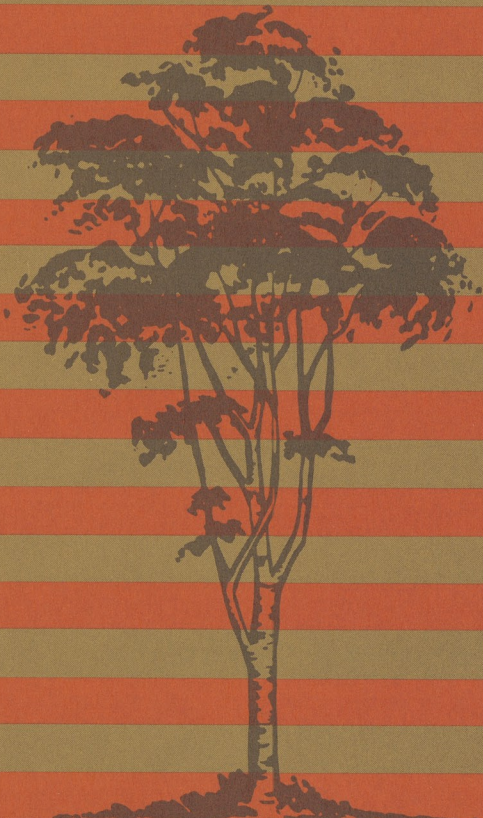
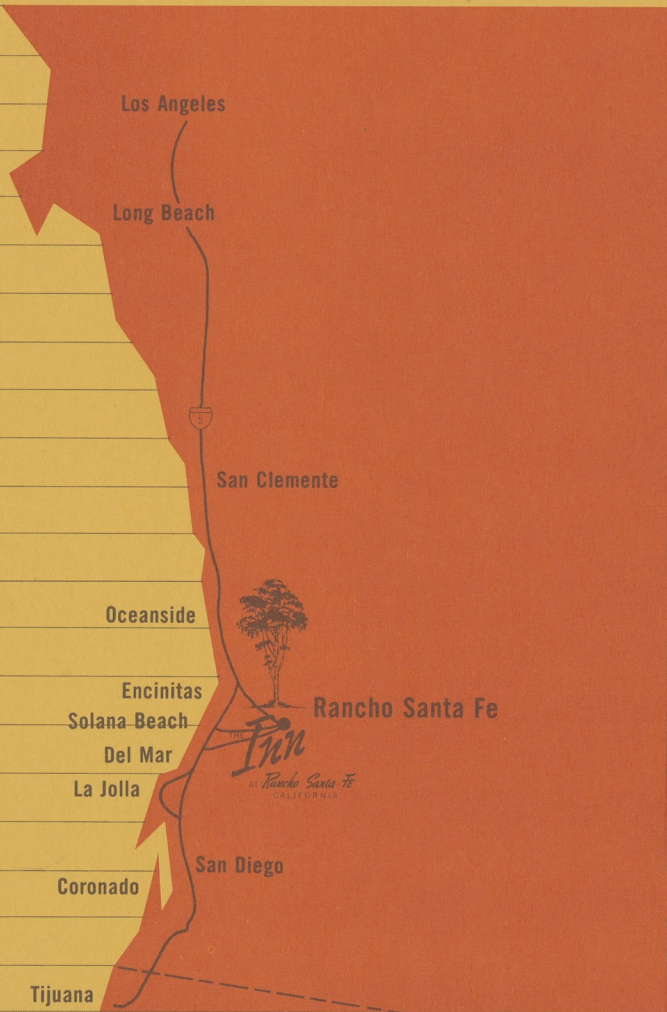
