A two-color lithograph printed as follows:

1. Zinc: blue-green (60% Hanco Opaque White, 39% Hanco Thalo Blue (Red), 1% Hanco Leaf Brown). Execution: ink flat rolled on dry plate and printed.
2. Stone: red (25% Sinclair & Valentine Permanent Rose Red, 24% Hanco Fire Red, 1% Sinclair & Valentine Tamarind Green, 50% Hanco Opaque White). Execution: mixture of Harris Triple Ink, asphaltum, and lithotine applied with brush over gum stop-out.

Paper size 30" x 22", torn and deckle edges; bleed image.

- 1 Bon a Tirer on Copperplate Deluxe
- 9 Tamarind Impressions on German Etching paper
- 20 artist's edition (numbered) on Copperplate Deluxe
- 1 cancellation proof on German Etching paper

All other proofs and impressions have been destroyed.

The zinc plate has been effaced.

The stone has been effaced.
