Dear Harry,

In ref. to the old church +
cemetery on Oak Rd.:

The church was called
the Mill Creek Presbyterian
Church. It is listed in the
Ky. reports during the
1790's for the Northwest
Territory. The cemetery
was located in the church
yard. The church building
still stood as long as 1869
but ^{the church} split during the 1840's
or 50's to form the Glendale
Presbyterian Church + the
Sharonville Presbyterian
Church. The land is now

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owned by the Alico Co.
where Oak Rd crossed
the canal. The preacher
always lived in the Eliza
House which was a farm
house close by.

Rev. John E. Morris and
his wife Sarah Stillman
members of my family
lived in the Eliza House
and had the farm & church.
Rev. John Morris gave up
the church to fight against
slavery. Some of their
children & I believe John
& Sarah were buried
in the cemetery. No markers

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exists in the cemetery today.
All destroyed by so called
progress.
