Please tell us as much as you can about the history of your house so we can preserve this information for future generations. In 100 years, even a new house today will be historic.

Suggested information:

- 155 Magnolia - built by Henry + Emma Woods 1962. They lived next door in Gunnison House - 820 Ivy - while 155 Magnolia being built. Emma developed cancer*
- Your house address *155 Magnolia*
 - Names of persons currently living at this address. How long? *A moving in. Henry sold the house to Charles + Mary Burdene about 1972. Charles died of emphysema about 1980. Mary died about 1986. Tom + Diane Todd bought*
 - Tell us as much as you know about previous owners or occupants. Do you know the names of the original occupants? *about Sept 1987 have lived here since*
 - Tell us as much as you know about when the house was built and any significant changes over the years. Do you know the name of the builder? *1962. Abbotson Chester Road*
 - (1) potty shed *bed* (2) Corner - turned into sewing room, then *bed room*
 - (3) 1999 - enlarged kitchen, eliminated maid's room *moved cellar stairs to side of room*
 - Do you have pictures of your house or occupants that you would give to us or let us copy?
 - Do you have any maps, drawings, or records about the history of your house? *Build on Anderson property - Neo Classical Design. Three antique fireplaces built into house. Front door very thick for old house. Walls thickened in main part of house to add charm.*
 - What interesting events have happened at your house? Is there a link with other Glendale residents or organizations? *Decorations for house next door added to ceiling in foyer. Decorations had been moved ~~into~~ from Gunnison House when 2nd Floor eliminated. Original gas grill built into wall in kitchen in 1962*
