These wooden teels were used by Jehn Henry Cook in the making of the fine weedwork (Doors, windows, etc.) found in the construction of many of the old homes of Glendale built between 1860 and 1873. As a partner of the Shaffer Construction Co., Cook did the fine cabinet work and weed carvings. Examples of his work can be found in the Old McGrew House at 930 Forest Ave., the Old Cook House at 20 E. Sharon Ave., the Old Cook House at 969 Congress Ave., The Swedenbergian Church on Congress Ave., etc.
