These weeden teels were used by John Henry Cook in the making of the fine weedwork ( Deers, windows, etc.) found in the construction of many of the old hemes of Glendale built between 1860 and 1873. As a partner of the Shaffer Construction Co., Cook did the fine cabinet work and wood carvings. Examples of his work can be found in the Old McGrew House at 930 Ferest Ave., the Old Cook House at 20 E. Sharon Ave., the Old Cook House at 969 Congress Ave., The Swedenbergian Church on Congress Ave., etc.
