

History of House at 795 Greenville

Dec. 20, 1953

According to Mr. Charles A. Blinn, this house was built about 1879, by a carpenter - contractor named Hickox, who lived here in Glendale. At the same time he built two other similar houses in Glendale. One on Greenville nearer the village square, and the other on east Sharon Ave. It was in this second house (on Sharon) that Mr. Blinn's father moved when Charles Blinn was about 8 years old.

February 6, 1956

According to Parker Morgan, his house was built in 1881. This information was derived from the abstract of title.

April 18, 1970

The oak tree near the north property line, cut down Nov. 1, 1969, was 101 years old, establishing the date of planting as 1868.
