

15 East Sharon, The Youse House, was the home of Grand Finale originators, Chef Larry & Cindy Harlan Youse for 33 years. Built in 1920, this Craftsman style home was extensively remodeled in 1978, when Cindy added the second floor dining room, a kitchen of antique drugstore cabinetry, a two sided fireplace, a solid brass handrail & created the third floor loft... and in 1990, added the porch-like sunroom and marble bath.. In 1988, Cindy Youse designed the unique hand-painted playroom for new baby, Zach...which won second place in Metropolitan Home playroom contest. In 1998, the carriage house was transformed into the Artist's Studio. This home was also featured in Cincinnati Magazine & Invitation Magazine for its eclectic style. Best features = Grand Finale room service!!....AND New Glendale artist, Rachael Hrnyak and husband, Kevin Wilhelm.

17 East Sharon Ave., The Youse's guest house was also built in 1920, then remodeled in 1978 and again in 2007, with a new kitchen, retro beadboard walls, leaded glass windows, antique iron stairrail, a "little girl's attic", & retaining its original pine floors & French porcelain tiles. This little Victorian cottage is now the funky, antique packed, Midwest atelier (home/studio) of oil painter, Cindy Harlan & Chef Larry Youse .( CH Youse paintings can be seen year-round at Grand Finale Restaurant & on the web, CHYOUSEFINEART.com ).
