Blond Patrons de Vries at Tappan 1635
bought land from Indians. A few battles
Hijack provided war with Indians
at one massacre 1648.

Tappan Patent 1682-87 when de Vries had long
gone back to Holland. His first stories of
expansion 1' long etc. Grants 15000 of Province of New
York, but he meant him to have the grant
He made of apt Indian trails. House up a
slope from roads.

Har of Paterson de Vries

Kakiat cut off from Haverstrait Precinct
along lines "N.W. Corner Clarkstown along north boundary
lands of Francis Furness and Benjamin Cox and
Gabriel Cucklin & Jonathan Seaman. This was in
March 1791 & Kakiat had come to be called New
Hempstead. Name changed to Ramapo 1828.
Rolland was cut off from Orange 1798 after 3
abortive attempts. County had been established in 1683
1st child born in Kakiat was Jacobina Seaman.
Lots sold in the 1st quarter of 18th C. for \$150.

Note Indian here now
