FACULTY SCHOLARSHIP

I. Name--Central Faculty Merit Award

II. Criteria for selection of Student:

1. This student shall have exhibited scholarship in high school sufficient to do creditable college work.
2. Character
3. Need
4. All faculty members who have the desire to do so, shall have the opportunity to participate in selection of this student.
5. The student selected shall not receive another scholarship.
6. There will be two students, one white and one black who will be awarded \$50.00 each.

III. Amount of Award--\$100.00 total; 2 scholarship, \$50.00 each.

If balance in Faculty Fund is less than \$100.00 the amount lacked will be donated from faculty members. Certificate of Merit to be awarded at graduation with money to be paid to the college of the student's choice.

IV. Alternates should be chosen but not announced. If for any reason the student(s) chosen does (do) not elect to attend school of advanced study, the alternative student(s) should receive the benefits of the scholarship. If the alternates do not attend a school, the scholarship money remains in the Faculty Fund.

V. Presentation by Faculty member chosen by the faculty each year.

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FACULTY FUND

Faculty dues are \$5.00 per year. Dues will be collected through the month of October. Dues paid after November 3 will be subject to a \$1.00 fine.

- I. Flowers will be sent to family members in the hospital. Cards will be sent to family members that are reported.
- II. Weddings--gifts will be given.
- III. Babies--gifts will be sent.
- IV. Funerals--pot plant or wreath will be sent.
- V. Retirement--gift suitable to situation.

Central High School faculty members should assume the responsibility of reporting illnesses.
