

PROGRAM OF STUDIES - CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL - 1968-69

The subjects shown in capitals are required. Students should schedule courses at the grade level offered or they may schedule some courses below present grade level. **EXAMPLE:** 10th grade student will normally schedule World History, however he may, if there is a need, schedule World Geography, which is offered in the 9th grade. He would not schedule American History, as it is a required 11th grade course. (Exception) -- Any exception to this procedure must be approved by the school counselor and principal. Students in 10th, 11th, & 12th grades below "B" average should not schedule more than four academic subjects. All 9th grade students must take 5 unit subjects. All students must schedule a minimum of 4 academic courses.

English IV-A --- For college bound Seniors scheduled by choice of student and parent.
9th grade Biology --- For those students who are recommended by their 9th grade teacher and with the approval of their parents.

General Biology --- For 10th grade students who scheduled General Science in the 9th grade and do not want the (BSCS) course in Biology.

Office Practice & Filing --- A student must have had 2 courses in Business Education or be registered for the 2nd course along with the Office Practice & Filing.

Stenoscrypt --- A one semester course for college bound senior only. Seniors who have had shorthand are not eligible for this course.

Speech I --- A one semester course for seniors.

Newspaper Staff --- For junior or senior students who have a "B" average in English.

In order to be admitted to Voc.-Tech. School a student must have a minimum of 14 units. They must be as follows:

- 3 units - English
- 1 unit - Health & P. E.
- 3 units - Math & Science (Combined)
- 3 units - Social Studies
- 4 units - Electives (Electives are to be chosen from other High School course offerings)

The following courses carry $\frac{1}{2}$ unit credit: Band, Chorus, Office Assist., Library Assist., Newspaper Staff, and Yearbook Staff.
