Central High School is very proud of its second graduating class and extends to each of you congratulations upon passing this milestone in your life.

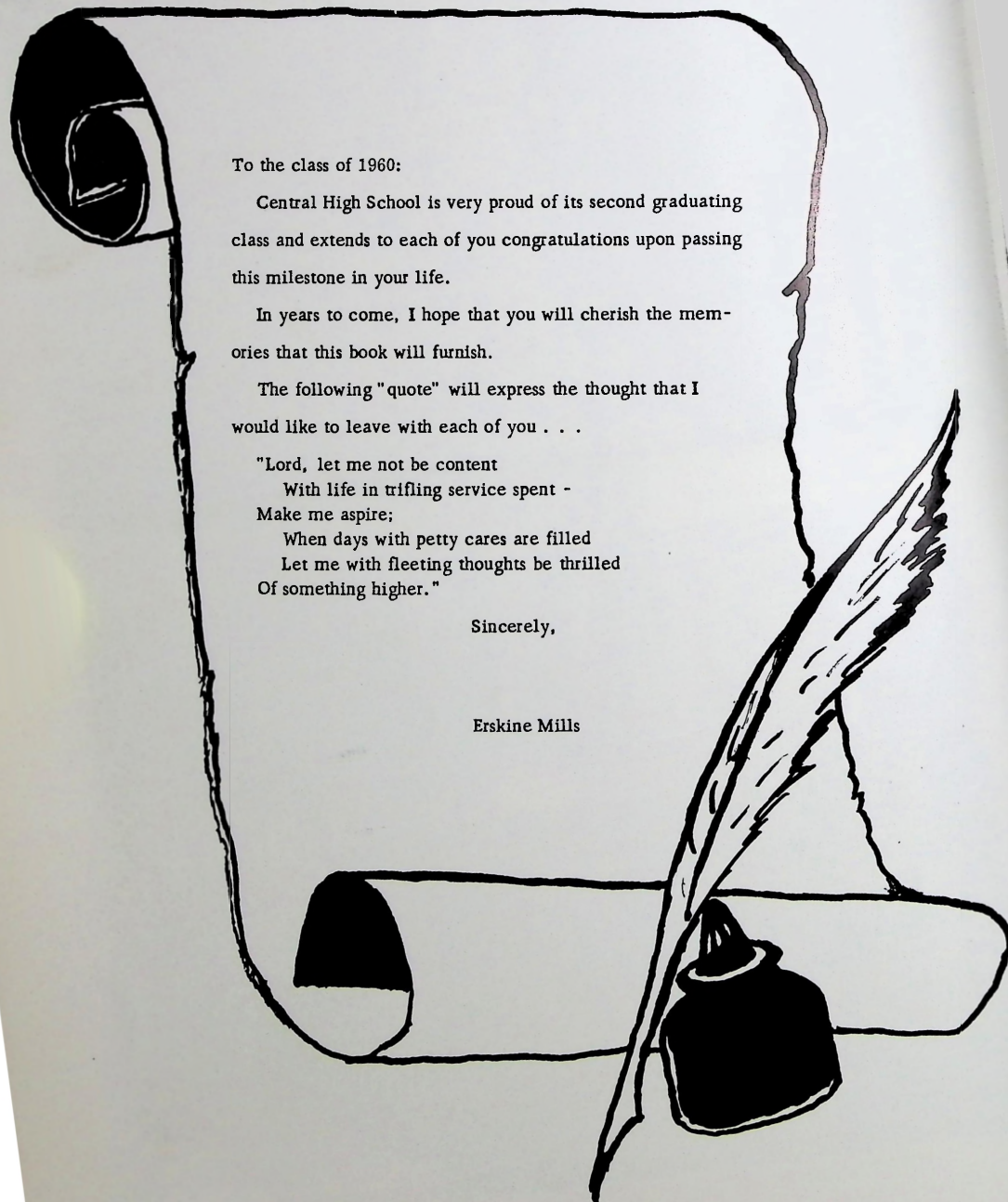
