

1970-71 Faculty Fund

Faculty dues are \$5.00 per year. A notice will be sent around the first of each month. You may pay by the month, semester, or the year.

Expenditures from the Faculty Fund will follow the plan below

I. Flowers or gifts will be sent to faculty members in the hospital at a cost of \$3.50. Cards will be sent to members of the family in the household if reported.

II. Weddings

1-3 years of service in Thomas County--\$10.00 gift from 3 years and on in service of Thomas County--\$20.00 gift.

III. Babies

Lady Faculty members and wife of Faculty members (while in service) \$3.50 gift.

IV. Funerals: Price \$10.00

A book will be placed *placed* in the library in memory of the person, plus a card or message will be sent to the family. A book will be placed for family members, husband, wife, children, mother, father, or any other member of the family living in the household. A book will be placed for County Officials and associate school staff-lunchroom workers.

V. Retirements

More than 5 years of service in this system, \$20.00 gift.

We recommend the faculty fund retain a balance of \$50.00 to take care of summer bills. All above this \$50.00 will be paid on Faculty Scholarship.

Every teacher should assume the responsibility of reporting illness.

A committee will be selected to purchase gifts for babies, weddings, etc.

FACULTY SCHOLARSHIP

I. Name - Central Faculty Merit Award

II. Criteria for selection of student

1. This student shall have exhibited scholarship in high school sufficient to do creditable college work.
2. Character
3. Need
4. All faculty members who desire to do so, shall have the opportunity to participate in the selection of this student.
5. The student selected shall not receive another scholarship.
6. There will be two students, one black, one white with the award being \$50.00 each.

III. Amount of Award

\$100.00

\$50.00 from the faculty fund. The remaining to be taken from the faculty fund if available or donated if necessary.

IV. Certificate of Merit to be awarded at graduation with money being paid to college of student's choice when enter (fall or summer).

Alternate:

Alternates to be chosen

Alternates shall be told, but not announced at graduation.

V. Presentation:

To be presented by a faculty member chosen by the faculty each year.
