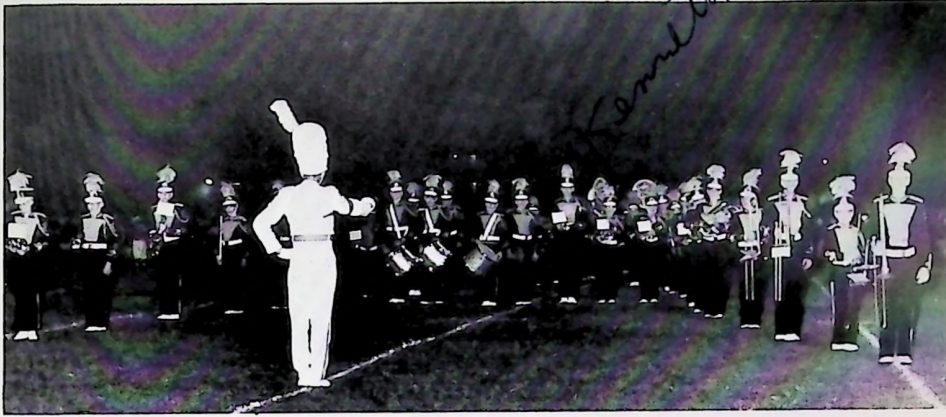


Band Supports School Spirit

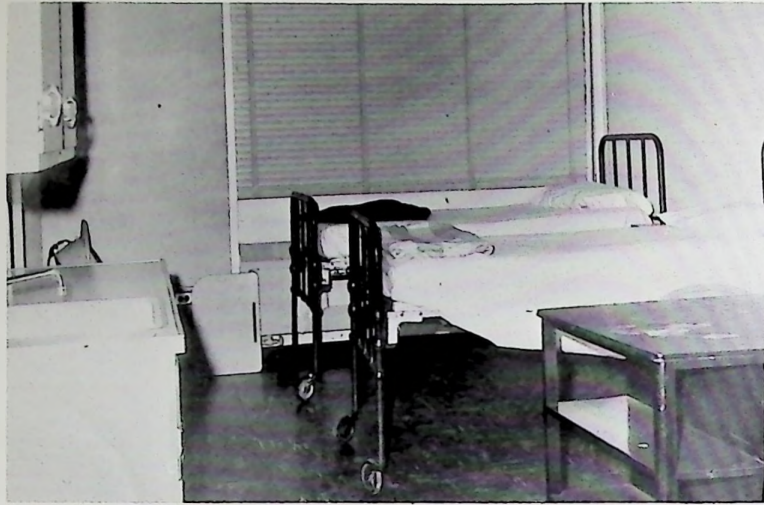
