PREFACE

Teachers, you will note that there have been quite a few changes made in your routine for the 1975-76 school year.

Please adapt and carry out these changes. Especially attend to your duty when you supervise students. It seems that negligence is the prime target for liability at the present time. You are responsible for the group or duty that you have.

The school day will consist of the hours 8:00 A. M. until 3:30 P. M. This means that you are to be already signed in and in your classroom by 8:00 A. M. This gives you time to get ready for the day before 8:15, when first period class begins. Should you be tardy and anything unusual takes place in your group, any liability resulting from it is yours.

Mr. Delaney and Mr. Cooley will handle all student discipline. My plans are to spend the major part of the day visiting class rooms. This will give the office a better understanding of the curriculum and teaching procedures. No plans are made to schedule these visits. A conference with the teacher and principal probably will be needed after a visitation. This activity is for the purpose of improving instruction.

No teacher or staff member is to leave campus without signing out on the register in the main office. Sign in upon your return.

Mr. Conner and Mr. Garland do not have homerooms. They have early morning bus duty and walk duty during homeroom.

During the homeroom period do not allow students to leave your room unless it is vitally necessary. Fill out the walk pass slip if one must leave.

You are responsible and liable for the students under your supervision as assigned to you. They should be kept with you unless there is a valid reason. Be sure that any student has the proper pass completely filled out before he leaves you.

DO NOT SEND ANY STUDENT OFF CAMPUS FOR ANY REASON.

FACULTY MEETINGS

Faculty meetings will be each Monday immediately after school. This weekly get together is vital to school and faculty cohesion. Teachers should arrange their schedule in order to be present. Appointments, courses, and other conflicts will be expected to be secondary to faculty meetings.

BUS DUTY

Immediately after the dismissal bell rings four teachers will assume bus duty and supervision - two teacher on the east side of the buildings and two teachers on the west side of the buildings. This duty consist of supervision of loading and unloading buses and all student behavior. Any type of accident or any student behavior beyond the teacher's control will be immediately reported to the office. This duty terminates daily after the last bus has pulled out. It will be rotated with everyone getting the same amount of duty time. Men who are on duty at football games will not have bus duty. A schedule will be put in each teacher's hands. Do not attempt to change this schedule without the approval of the principal.

EXCUSES

We will begin writing excuses at 7:45 a. m. When a student comes in on the bus, he can get the excuse immediately. Only students who need to get excuses will be allowed in the administration building.

At 8:15 a. m. excuse writing stops. Students who did not get excuses will come back at recess. A student has a maximum of three (3) days after returning to school after an absence to get his excuse for absenteeism. A student not bringing proper excuse from the office is automatically unexcused.

TARDIES

Each teacher will be responsible for their tardies. Three (3) tardies in a class or homeroom constitute an absence in keeping with type of tardy. Please bring student to the office after three tardies.

REPORTING EXCESSIVE ABSENTEES

Anytime a student is absent three (3) days consecutively the teacher should report this to Mr. Malone on the form provided during the day of the third absence. Make another report on the fifth day and the tenth day of absence.

TELEPHONE CALLS

No person is to make a long distance call from 226-5825, 226-5826, or 226-5827 without the approval of the Principal. This will be done by making out the form Mrs. Pullen will provide for you. Encourage your students not to use the telephone unless it is of pure necessity. Departments with telephones should be prudent with long distance calls and student use. Sometimes a dime letter is also proof of the message.

CLUBS

Clubs will meet the week of the third Monday of each month. They will meet on the designated day at the planning period of the sponsoring teacher. Students who are members of a club will be excused from classes for the club period. The student is responsible for making up work missed for a club meeting. The teacher will cooperate in this matter. A list of members for all clubs will be furnished to every teacher soon after the initial meeting of the club.

MONEY RAISING PROJECTS

All money raising projects must be approved by the Principal. Approval is given on the form provided by the office. Be very careful that all merchandise checked out and money turned in is accounted for. You are responsible.

BLINDS

Teachers the blinds have been restrung and reworked. They are old and will not work like new ones. Please do your own blind adjustments. Do not allow students to do this. In some of the rooms the blinds were in excellent shape while others were torn apart.

TEACHER ABSENTEES & SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS

If for some valid reason you are unable to attend school you are to notify Ms. Joanne Pullen immediately. Her telephone number is 226-8564. You are not to get the substitute. She will. Any negotiation about substitute will be done with her. You are not to pay the substitute. The Thomas County Board of Education will do this. Always provide lesson plans if humanly possible.

* PURCHASE ORDERS

Anything you buy that is to be paid for by school funds of any kind must be accompanied by a purchase order. Purchase orders can be gotten from the secretary. We plan to withhold payment where there is no purchase order.

RECORDS & REPORTS

The keeping of good, accurate records and turning in correct reports on time is another responsibility of every teacher.

The attendance registers must be kept accurately. Study and go by the instructions in front of the register. Keep this record accurately as it is most important as well as legally significant.

Your class record of each student can be scrutinized by his parents. Be careful that you can justify the grade given. Mid-term and end of quarter report cards go out the fifth school day following the end of that period of time. Grades will go on the mid-term report this year.

Record class absentees daily and accurately. Fill out your daily class absentee slips and put on the outside of your class room door. Record your tardies also.

The registers are due in the office the morning after the last day of each month, summarized and balanced. A record is kept of teachers whose registers are not correct.

In any class if a student is not doing well it is the teacher's duty to call the parents. If you are unable to make contact write a note. The office will stamp it and mail it for you. In home room and in all classes addresses and telephone numbers are necessary.

MONEY

Any money a teacher collects from students at school or involving any school activity must be turned in to the office and receipted. County correctly, place in envelope with your name and what the money was collected for, the amount in the envelope and drop in the slot of the money box before 1:00 P. M.

Keep accurate records on any and all money you handle. The most important of all collections is for school insurance. You could probably be held liable for your mistake.

Remember you are personally responsible for the money collected. Do not leave it on your desk or in your room. Stolen money is most difficult to recover and most of us teachers are not financially able to replace these funds.

DISCIPLINE

As the discipline goes - so goes the class. Each teacher has the obligation of disciplining his class. In addition it is also the duty of the teacher to correct the misbehavior of any student at Central High School during the school day or at any school function.

If there is a student discipline problem that the teacher can not handle it is to be brought to the office. Do not bring petty things such as tardies, gum chewing or hair combing. Students respect and respond to the teacher who can handle his own problems. Some thought has been given to making a teacher chart on the wall that will show the number of times and students that a teacher brings to the office.

SIGN IN

When you arrive at school come by the office and sign in. Do not ask someone to do it for you. Check your mail box. This sign in sheet is very important. We use it in making out the sick leave report. You might be charged a day if you haven't signed in. Eight (8:00) A. M. is the time to be in your class room.

CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL FIRE DRILL PROCEDURE

This procedure is to be read to the homeroom students. It should be fully explained. Keep it on file for future reference.

1. The signal for the fire drill is one long blast of the fire alarm.
2. Students are to remain completely silent during the entire drill. Only the teacher will talk.
3. When the alarm sounds, the teacher will direct the appropriate students to close the windows and turn off all lights and electrical appliances. The door is to be closed by the last student leaving the room.
4. The teacher is to lead the students in single file by the nearest route to the curb or the ditch of the street indicated in item five (5).

5. Students and teachers in Rooms 101, 102, 103, 104, 105, 106, 107, 108, 109, 110, 111, 112, 113, 200, 201, 202, 203, 204, 205, 206, 207, 208, 209, 210, 211, 212, 213, A11, A13, A14, office building, lunchroom, and library will go to the curb on Pinetree Boulevard.

Students and teachers in Rooms 300, 301, 304, 305, 306, 307, 308, 309, 310, 311, 312, 313, 314, 315, 316, 317, 318, and 319 will go to the ditch on Highway 319.

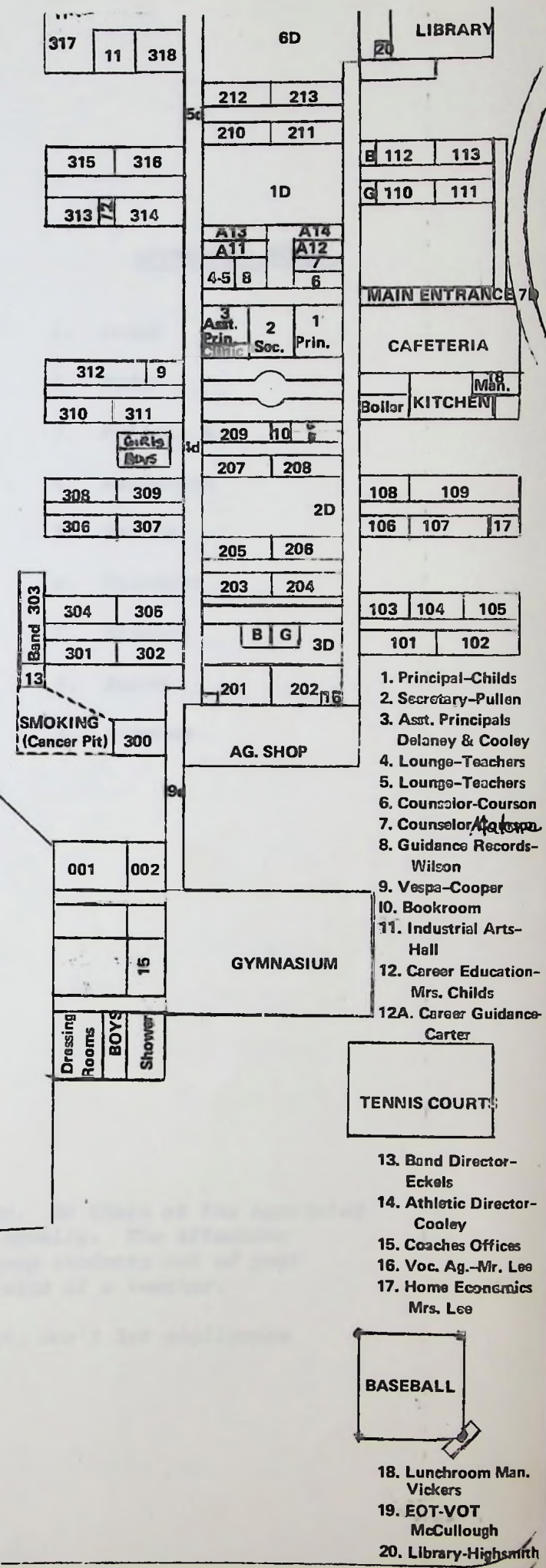
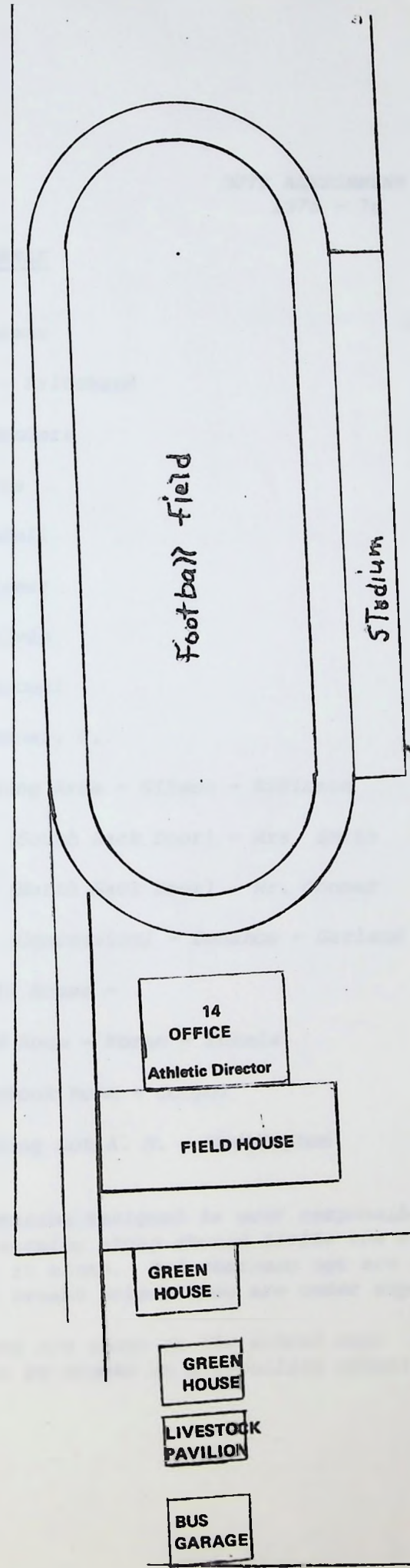
Students and teachers in any part of the Gymnasium will go through the front of the gym to the curb on Pinetree Boulevard.
