- Chase, Abby.** Age 21. Boarder with Morris Smith and Isabella (Leavitt) Smith; Isabella is Simon Howard's older sister by 7½ years.
- Cotton, George D.** Age 32. Farm laborer. Living with his father, Jonathan Cotton. Married to Addie P., son is Fred L.
- Dalton, Eben Leavitt.** Age 40. 1836–1924. Buried in Little River Cemetery.
- Dearborn, John.** Age 67. 1811–1880; buried in Center Cemetery.
- Dearborn, Lawrence.** Age 58. Farmer.
- Drake, Freeman.** Age 44. 1804–1931; buried in Center Cemetery. Brother of two of SHL's uncles by marriage. Son of Samuel and Mehitabel Drake; they are the parents of Samuel Jenness Drake (married SHL's half-sister Mary Leavitt) and Joshua Pickering Drake (married Simon Howard's sister Sarah Drake Leavitt).
- Drake, Hettie Pickering.** Age 10. SHL's cousin. Daughter of Joshua Pickering and Sarah Drake (Leavitt) Drake; Sarah Drake was SHL's older sister by 21 years.
- Drake, Justin Edwards.** Age 20. 1855–1938; buried in Center Cemetery. SHL's cousin. Son of Joshua Pickering and Sarah Drake (Leavitt) Drake; Sarah Drake was SHL's older sister by 21 years.
- Drake, Mary (Leavitt).** Age 57. 1881–1882; buried in Center Cemetery. SHL's half-sister, older by 25 years. Daughter of Simon Leavitt IV and Abigail (Chapman) Leavitt; Abigail was Simon's first wife and possibly the sister of his second wife, Juliana.
- Drake, Samuel Jenness.** Age 58. 1821–1891; buried in Center Cemetery. SHL's brother-in-law; he was married to Mary (Leavitt), SHL's half-sister.
- Drake, Sarah L.** Could be Sarah Drake (Leavitt) Drake, SHL's sister.
- French, John Farrar.** Age 60. 1818–1900; buried in Center Cemetery. Son of Jonathan and Rebecca (Farrar) French. Jonathan French was North Hampton's minister from 1801–1856.
- French, Samuel Farrar.** Age 69. 1809–1899; buried in Center Cemetery. Son of Jonathan and Rebecca (Farrar) French. Jonathan French was North Hampton's minister from 1801–1856.
- Frost, George.** Age 21.
- Gove, Abbie (Philbrick).** Age 53. Wife of Ebenezer Gove, sister of Thomas Philbrick.
- Hobbs, A.D.** May be Abraham D. Age 42.
- Hobbs, James F.** Age 34. The second cousin of Morris Hobbs Smith; his father Jonathan III (ca 1805–1872) was the son of Lieut. Jonathan (ca 1769–1844) who was the son of Morris (1747–1844). Morris Hobbs Smith was the son of Elizabeth Cotton (Hobbs) Smith (1802–1884), who was the daughter of Dea. Morris Hobbs (ca 1776–1830) who was also the som of Morris (1747–1844). Charles Smith was boarding with JFH in 1880; relationship between Charles Smith and Morris Hobbs Smith (and therefore James F. Hobbs) is unknown.
- Hobbs, John S.** Age 61.
- Hobbs, John W.** Age 31.
- Hobbs, John W.F.** Age 63.
- Jenness, Alfonzo.** Age 35. Farmer.
- Jenness, Edwin.** Age 59. Farmer. May be Alfonzo Jenness's father.

Knowles, David. Age 60. Father of Thomas Knowles.

Knowles, Tom. Age 36. Son of David Knowles.

Leavitt, James R. Age 62. 1815–1897; buried in Center Cemetery. Living next door to SHL in 1880.

Leavitt, John. Age 54. 1823–1891; buried in Center Cemetery. A bachelor living with his sister Sarah in 1880.

Leavitt, Juliana (Chapman). Age 72. 1805–1885; buried in Center Cemetery. Daughter of Samuel and Mercy Chapman. Second wife of Simon Leavitt IV; possibly sister of his first wife, Abigail Chapman. Mother of SHL.

Locke, Freeman. Age 34.

Locke, Morris. Age 50.

Lynch, Patrick. Age 55. Born in Ireland.

Marston, George. Age 44. 1833–1914; buried in Center Cemetery. Produce dealer.

Marston, Thomas Edward. Age 30. 1848–1935; buried in Center Cemetery.

Marston, Thomas F. Age 52. 1825–1920; buried in Center Cemetery. Carriage maker.

Moore, George. Age 22. A boarder in North Hampton in 1880.

Moulton, Fremont. Age 22. 1855–1916; buried in Little River Cemetery.

Norris, Abbot. Age 40. Grocer.

Philbrook, Harlan Leavitt. Age 18. 1860–1948, buried in Center Cemetery. SHL's cousin. Son of Henry M. and Rebecca French (Leavitt) Philbrook; Rebecca was SHL's older sister by 12 years.

Philbrook, Joseph L. Age 50. ca 1827–1904; buried in Center Cemetery. SHL's brother in law; married to his sister Julia Mianda Leavitt.

Philbrook, Julia Elizabeth "Lizzie." Age 19. 1859–1943; buried in Center Cemetery. SHL's cousin. Daughter of Joseph L. and Julia Mianda (Leavitt) Philbrook; Julia was SHL's older sister by 16 years. Lizzie married Wilfred Chevalier.

Philbrook, Julia Mianda (Leavitt). Age 48. 1830–1927; buried in Center Cemetery. SHL's older sister by 16 years. Married to Joseph L. Philbrook. Mother of Julia Elizabeth "Lizzie" and Allen Howard (died age 4). Not living in North Hampton in 1880 but is living there in 1900.

Philbrook, Rebecca French (Leavitt). Age 44. 1834–1899; buried in Center Cemetery. Married to Henry M. Philbrook. SHL's older sister by 12 years. Her husband, Henry M. Philbrook, died in 1865, 13 years before the diary was written. She had two children, Willard Henry and Harlan Leavitt Philbrook.

Philbrook, Willard Henry. Age 21. 1857–1951; buried in Center Cemetery. SHL's cousin. Eldest son of Rebecca French (Leavitt) Philbrook.

Robinson, Albert "Bart." Age 32.

Robinson, Jonathan Page. Age 71. 1807–1897; buried in Center Cemetery. Boarding with Simon Brown in 1880.

Rollins, Jonathan. Age 44. Grocer.

Seavey, Arthur E. Age 15. 1863–1945; buried in Center Cemetery. Oldest son of Charles Seavey.

Seavey, Charles E. Age 43. 1834–1894; buried in Center Cemetery. Blacksmith. Lived near SHL.

Sleeper, John. Age 36.

Smith, Charles E. Age 22. A farm laborer, living in North Hampton in 1880, boarding with James F. Hobbs. James F. Hobbs is a second cousin to Morris Hobbs Smith, but the connection (if any) between Morris Hobbs Smith and Charles E. Smith is unknown.

Smith, Edward Morris. Age 12. 1866–1943; buried in Center Cemetery. SHL's cousin. Son of Morris Hobbs and Isabella (Leavitt) Smith; Isabella was SHL's older sister by 7 years.

Smith, Isabella "Bell" (Leavitt). Age 39. 1839–1905; buried in Center Cemetery. SHL's next oldest surviving sibling, his older sister by 7 years. Married to Morris Hobbs Smith. Their family was living next door to SHL in 1880. Her two surviving children were Edward Morris and Anna Bell.

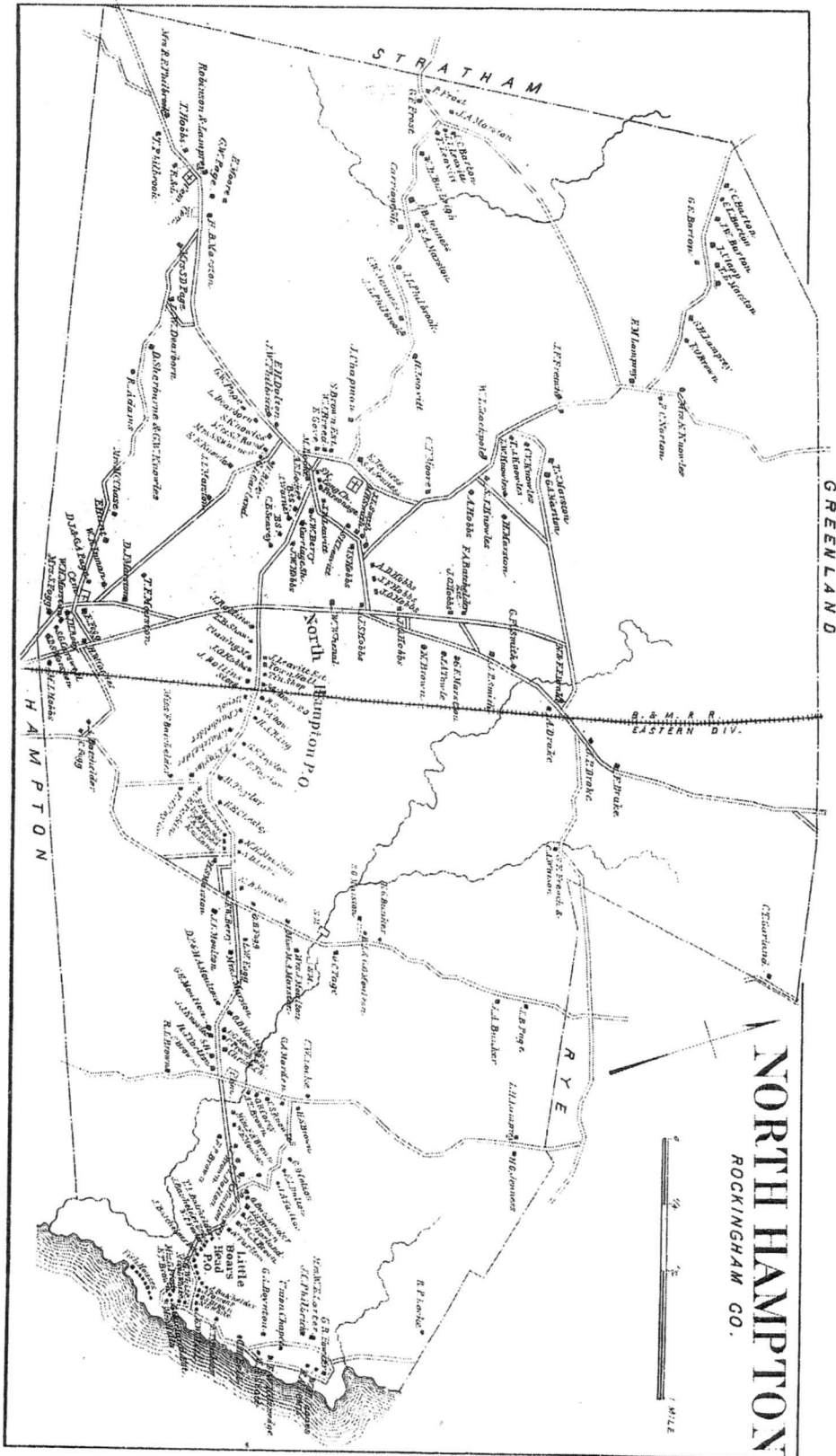

- Whenal, Robert.** Age 13. 1865–1933; buried in Center Cemetery. Second son of William and Jane Brown Whenal.
- Whenal, William.** Age 47. 1831–1893; buried in Center Cemetery. Farm laborer. Wife was Jane Brown; children included Robert (age 13) and William G. (age 15). Lived near Charles Batchelder. Much of the family was born in Scotland.
- Whenal, William "Willie" G.** Age 15. Born ca 1864 in Scotland. Married Grace Stewart of Haverhill, MA, 28 June 1887. Not buried in Center Cemetery. Not living in North Hampton in 1900.

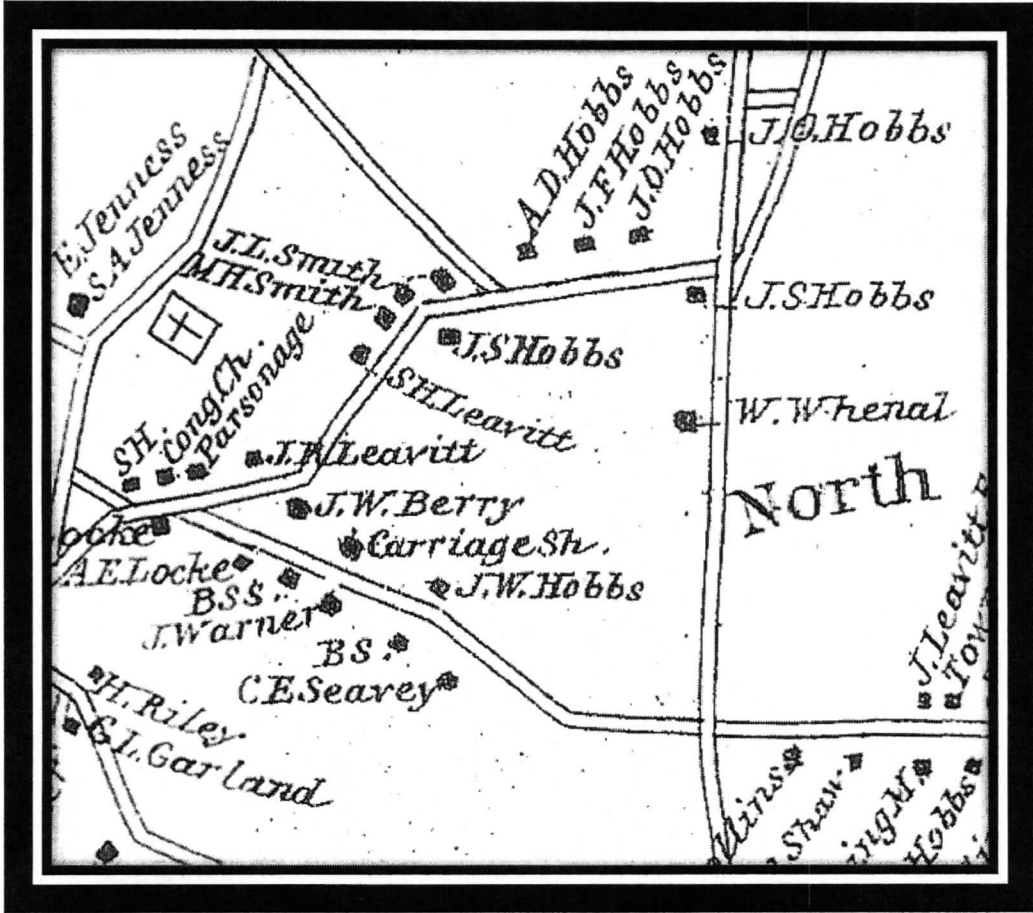
