- (i) Credit paybook of soldier with leave ration allowance for period of leave granted in UK (3/4d per diem). Entry will show "RA—days Pt II—d/—". Pt II Order No. will be inserted against entry after soldier has returned from leave.
- (ii) Ensure that soldier has in his possession the equivalent in local currency of at least \$10.00 to tender for exchange for Sterling on his arrival at Transit Camp Wing. If soldier has no local currency for exchange or an amount less than the equivalent of \$10,00, cash advance is to be made by pmr after crediting paybook with ration allowance and before leave cheque is issued.
- (iii) Ensure that particulars of all currencies soldier is entitled to exchange for Sterling are shown both on this form and reverse of Pt VI of Leave Pass AF W3145.
- (iv) Ensure that number and date of leave cheque are entered in soldier's paybook MBM 1 Part II.
- (v) In the case of debtor balance, total advance in cash and by leave cheque will be restricted to NET pay and ration allowance for period of leave.
- (vi) A soldier is permitted to draw currency from any available free balance over and above leave cheque which is limited to a maximum of £20-0-0.
