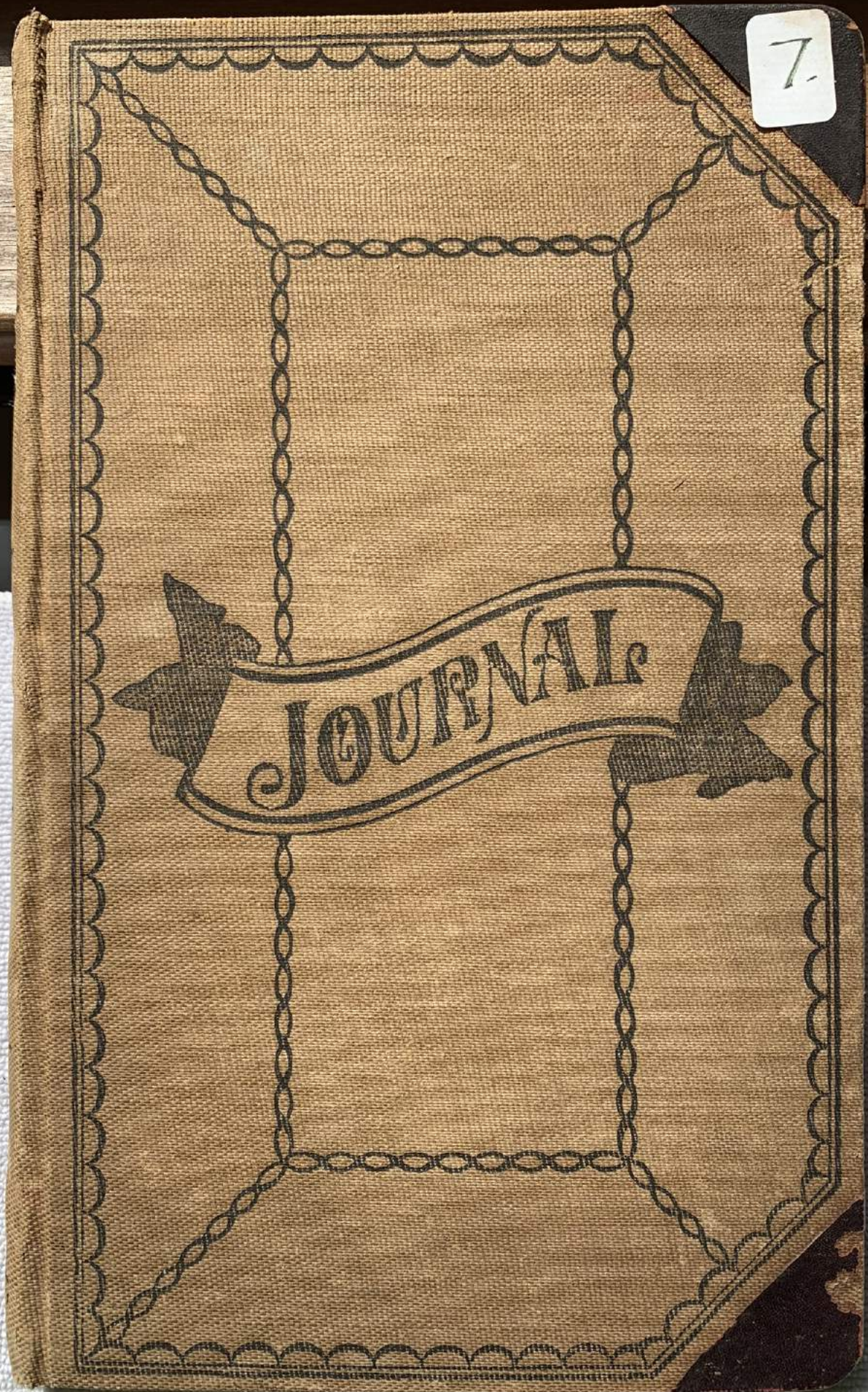
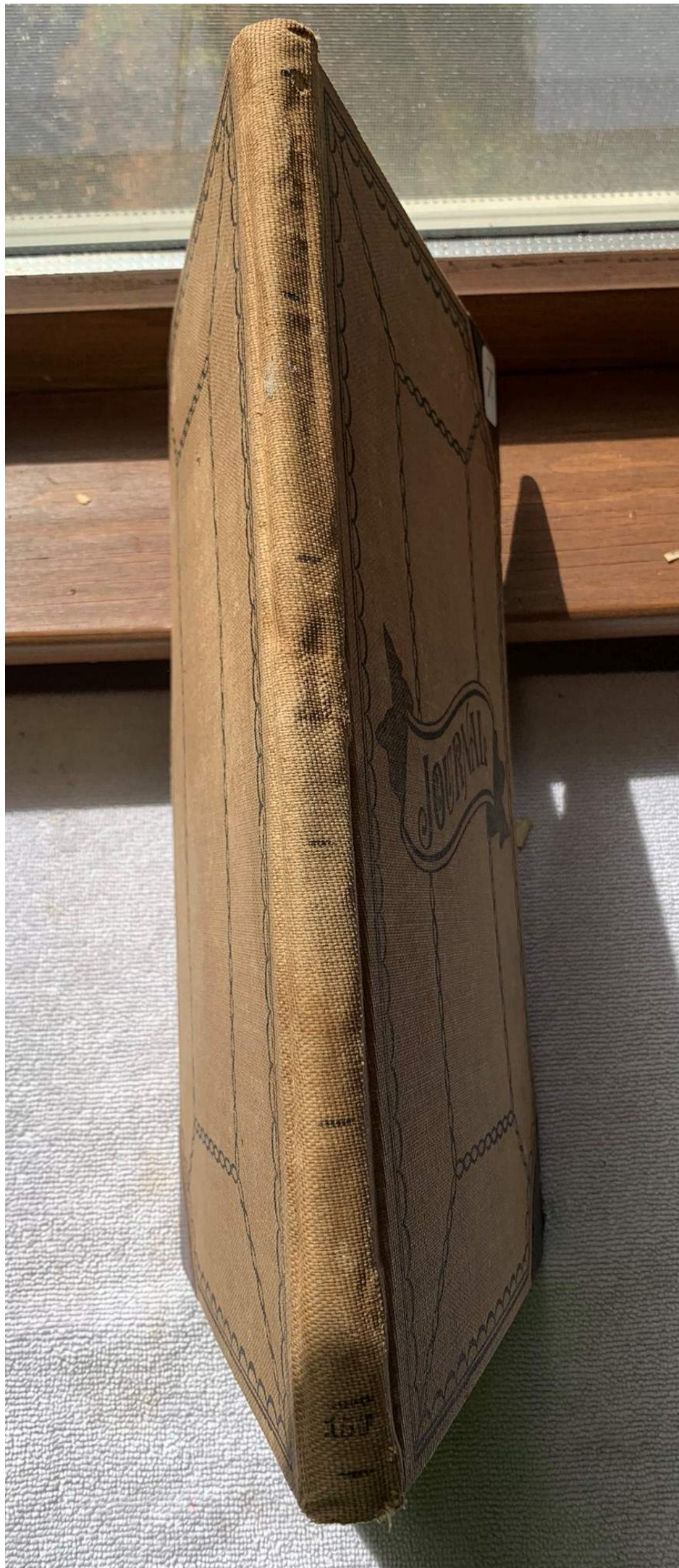

COLLECTOR'S RECEIPT.

"The Collector shall deliver a receipt to every person paying a tax, specifying the date of such payment, the name of such person, the description of the property as shown on the assessment-roll, the name of the person to whom the same is assessed, the amount of such tax, and the date of the delivery to him of the assessment-roll on account of which such tax was paid. For the purpose of giving such receipt, each Collector shall have a book of blank receipts, so arranged that when a receipt is torn therefrom, a corresponding stub will remain. The State Board of Tax Commissioners shall prescribe the form of such receipt, stubs and books, and they shall be furnished to the Collector by the Board of Supervisors, at the expense of the County. At the time of giving such receipt, the Collector shall make the same entries on the corresponding stub as are required to be made on the receipt. Such books shall be subject to public inspection, and shall be filed by the collector, with his return, together with the Assessment Roll, in the office of the County Treasurer."—Sec. 94, Chap. 908, Laws of 1897.

RECEIVED of New York Power and Light Corporation, Five Dollars (\$5.00) in consideration of which (I) (we) agree to sell and convey to said Corporation, its successors or assigns, the premises hereinafter described in and to execute and deliver a good and sufficient warranty deed conveying the same, free from all liens and encumbrances, upon payment of the further sum of \$ 15.00 Dollars within 30 months from the date hereof.

The premises to be so conveyed consist of a strip of land seventy-five feet in width, being thirty-seven and one-half feet on each side of a center line as now staked out and approximately described as follows: Beginning at a stake set in the ground in the division line between my land and the land of John C. Murphy. And in the division line between my land and the land of John C. Murphy. the Grantor to retain all mineral rights.

Together with the right at all times to cross and recross on foot and with teams and motor vehicles (our) (my) adjacent lands for the purpose of constructing, operating, inspecting or repairing any and all structures and fixtures which said Power Company, its successors or assigns, may erect, operate, construct or maintain upon the above described premises, said right of entry to be confined to routes designated by the undersigned if practicable and reasonable. All damage occasioned to (our) (my) remaining land in the exercise of said right of entry shall be paid by the Power Company.

Also, the right at all times to cut and remove such brush, trees or other obstructions upon (our) (my) remaining premises as may in the opinion of the Power Company, its successors or assigns, interfere with or be likely to interfere with the successful operation of its transmission lines.

Said deed shall except and reserve unto the undersigned the right to erect at the same place the premises to be conveyed at 2 points upon a strip of land not to exceed twenty-five feet in width and to be at points to be designated by the Power Company.

In further consideration of said sum of Five Dollars I hereby authorize the Power Company to enter upon said premises and construct its proposed transmission line system, provided, however, that this option shall be null and void unless the Power Company shall take title and tender the balance of the agreed consideration within 30 months from the date hereof, and provided further that if, at the time of such tender (I) (we) shall not be able to convey a clear unencumbered title, the Power Company may deposit the agreed consideration with the Union National Bank in the city of New York in discharge of its obligations hereunder, and any legal condemnation or other proceedings to acquire the said property, may put this agreement in evidence in said proceedings, and pending adjudication thereof, the right to enter and use said premises shall be a perpetual easement.
