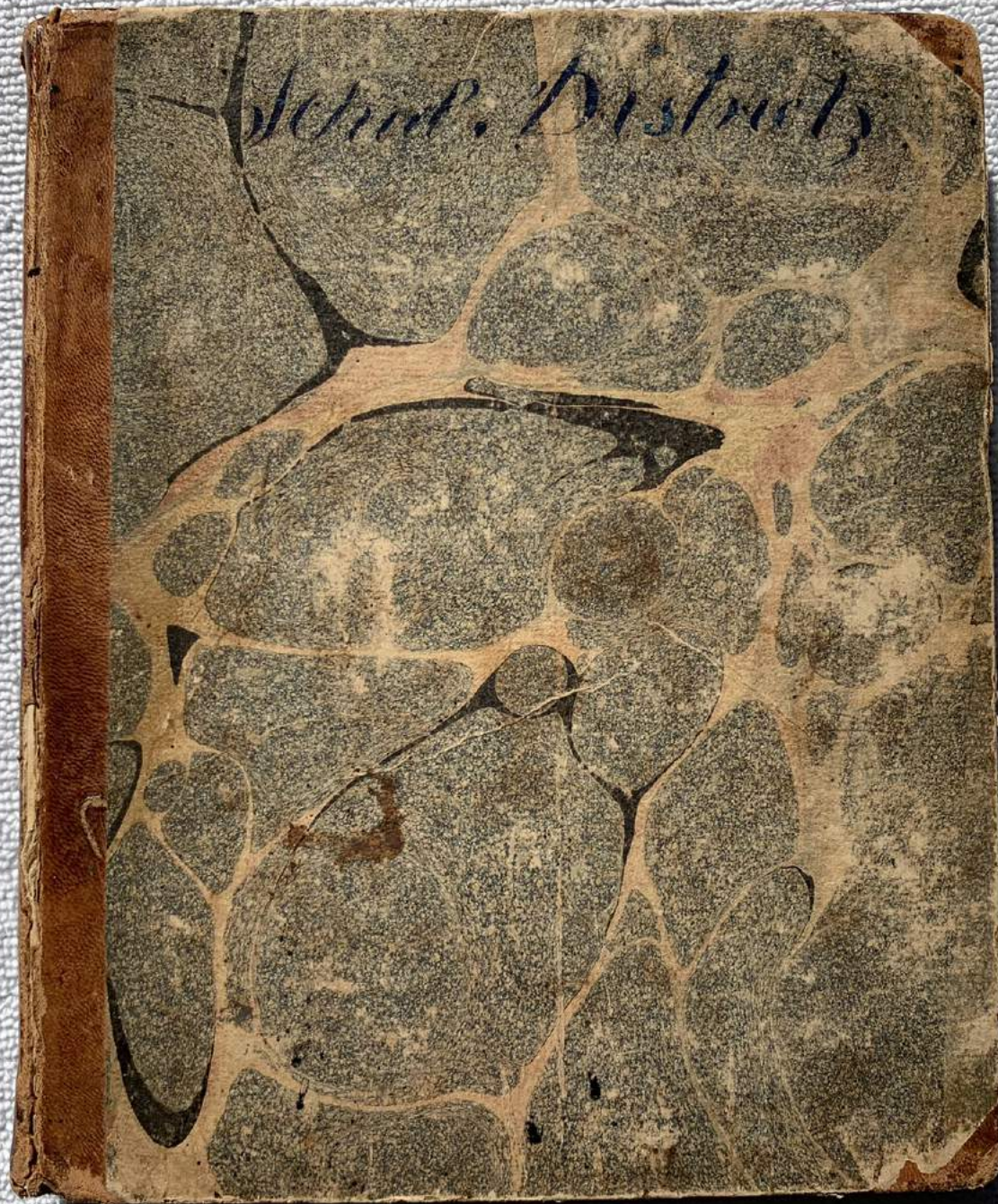

viz a crop and slit in the left ear
Sand Lake June 9th 1816

Svenill Wm hath recorded the mark of
his cattle sheep & swine to be recorded as follows
viz a swallow tail in each ear Sand Lake
April 9th 1825



Brownson Benjamin B. has Directed
the Mark of his Cattle & sheep
swine to be ^{run} as follows viz -
a half crop the under side of
each ear - Nov^r 1815

crop and a hole through the same
July 1813

Carpenter Philip has directed the mark of his
Cattle Sheep & Swine to be recorded as follows
Viz a small ad Tail in the Right Ear
April 1815 — 10

Clark William has directed the Mark of
his cattle Swine & Sheep to be recorded
as follows viz A crop on the left ear &
half crop on the under side of the wrought
ear Sand Lake Feb 8th 1819

Clark John hath Directed the Mark of his cattle
Swine & Sheep to be recorded as follows
viz Each ear cropt & A Slit in the
underside of the right ear
Sand Lake Apr 20th 1818

Cummings William has directed the
Mark of his cattle Swine & Sheep
to be recorded as follows viz a square
crop off the left ear -
June 8th 1819

Cambell Micah directed his marks of
Sheep & cattle to be recorded as follows viz
a half penny under the left ear and a
Slit in the end of both ears
Sand Lake Sept 27th 1820

Coons Abraham 2nd has directed the mark of
his cattle Sheep and Swine to be recorded as follows
viz a half penny out of the upper side of the
right ear and a half penny out of the under
sides of the left ear -
Sand Lake Oct 9th 1820

Coons Abraham has directed the mark of his
cattle Sheep & Swine to be recorded as follows viz
the left ear cut square of and a half penny
under the right ear -
Sand Lake Decr - 1st 1820

Chittman Keuben has directed the mark of his cattle
and Sheep to be recorded as follows viz
a crop off the right ear and a Slit in the left
ear -
March 20th 1821

Catrell George has Directed the marks
of sheep to be recorded as follows viz:
the right ear bent square a cross and
a hole through the same
June 24th 1943

Daniel Moore has Directed the marks
of his cattle to be recorded as
follows viz a split in the left
ear December 4th 1846

Delemaster Samuel has directed the
marks of his Sheep to be Recorded as
follows "N^o 1" A. halpunny taken out from
under the right ear near the head
January 1st. 1814

James Lewis has Directed the Mark
of his Cattle Sheep & Swine to be Recorded
as follows viz a hole in the right Ear
July 12th 1816

Feathers Henry has Directed the Mark
of his Cattle & Sheep to be Recorded as follows
viz a half crop on the under side
of the left Ear July 25th 1817
