## *History of St. Sylvester's Parish*

Today, November 25th, 1934, we celebrate the Fiftieth Anniversary of the first Holy Mass offered in St. Sylvester Church to the honor and glory of God, and commemorate fifty years of service and devotion under the guidance of our glorious patron.

And now let us turn back the pages of these fifty years and review in brief such items of history as can be obtained from the memory of those who are still with us and who attended the first Mass.

In the early days of 1884, Mr. Barney Kelly, baggage master for the C. & N. W. Ry., and a resident of what was known as the Township of Jefferson, met The Reverend Patrick Conway, Chancellor of the Archdiocese of Chicago, and in conversation on the train spoke of church work. Mr. Kelly stressed the great need of a church in Humboldt. So little was known of Humboldt and its surroundings at that time that Father asked, "where is Humboldt?"

Simultaneously the good people of the Maplewood, Avondale and Cragin districts sent a committee composed of Mrs. Franklin P. Handley, then Miss Mary A. Byrne, Mrs. Charles Heaney, Sr., and Mrs. William P. St. Clair, to Archbishop Feehan with a request that a Parish be formed in these localities to take care of the needs of the Catholic people.

Shortly after, thru the assistance of Father Conway, a representative was sent from the Chancellor's office and a meeting called at the home of Mrs. Jane Byrne. This meeting was attended by about fifteen people, among whom the following are still residents of St. Sylvester Parish:

At the time of the foundation of the parish its territory covered Humboldt, Jefferson, Maplewood and Avondale districts and even included the poor house and asylum at Dunning. The boundary lines were then designated as Chicago Avenue on the south, Western Avenue on the East, Dunning on the west and as far north as one could see. At that time for miles in all directions one could see forests, farms and country spaces; there were no street cars; sidewalks in few places; gravel streets were a luxury and the houses few and far apart. This made the work connected with the parish most arduous and demanded trials and sacrifices such as parishioners of today can scarcely imagine. Wagons and various kinds of vehicles brought the people from Cragin and other far points and it was many years before horse cars made their appearance.

In March, 1884, Reverend John J. Delaney was appointed Pastor and came to read the first Mass. No church was in existence and the Fire Engine House on Stave Street, then known as the Township of Jefferson Fire House, was the only available location. Permission was given for the use of the upper floor of the engine house and from then until November 25th, 1884, Mass was read every Sunday in this place.

Father Delaney cannot be too highly praised for his untiring labors connected with the work among his people preceeding the erection of the church. He lived in a very small house on what is known as Francis Place, and many times when coming to hear confessions had to walk through severe storms.

During the interval perceding the erection of the church building, the first marriage on the register of St. Sylvester's was performed, Father Delaney having made arrangements to perform the ceremony at St. Stephen's Church. The first bride and groom, Mr. and Mrs. Franklin P. Handley, are still residents of this parish and they, their children and grandchildren have been an honor to the parish these many years.

After hard work for many months, the church was built on property purchased by Father Delaney on California and Shakespeare Avenues. The name of St. Sylvester was selected by Father Delaney in honor of his father, Sylvester Delaney. The rectory was built on California Avenue next to the church.

For many years Sunday School was held in the church and the children of the parish were taught their catechism by young women of the parish who volunteered their services and who willingly gave their time to this good work. Miss Nellie Morrissey, now residing in Oak Park, was the first Sunday School Superintendent. It will not be amiss at this time to state that from among these groups of Sunday school children there have grown some of the outstanding men and women of today, of whom our parish can well be proud.

Father Delaney died on October 18th, 1889 and was burried in Albany, N. Y. He was succeeded by The Reverend Father Patrick Agnew.

Father Agnew was born in Dundee, Scotland in 1849. He received his theological education in Douai, France, finishing his studies in St. Sulpice, Paris, and was ordained to the priesthood in 1874. He was a gifted orator, an accomplished musician and one of the founders of the Catholic Summer School movement of which he was at one time president. Father Agnew's idea was to establish a school in the parish at once, but as the growth of the parish had not been such as to permit the same, he interested the adults and children in study clubs and debating societies during the period of his incumbency.

Father Agnew arranged for the sale of the church property on California Avenue to the City of Chicago for the Shakespeare Avenue Police Court and station, and purchased property on Richmond Street and Palmer Avenue. The church was moved from the old site to the new and the rectory moved to Palmer Avenue, the present location of the Sisters convent. At the same time the property on Humboldt Blvd., now occupied by the church and rectory, was purchased.

After a long and tedious illness Father Agnew died on July 31st, 1897 and was buried in Calvary Cemetery. He was succeeded by the Reverend Father Michael O'Brien. Many of the parishioners of today remember Father O'Brien. He was born in Ireland and his wit and lively manner made him loved and admired by Catholic and

non-Catholic. He would not purchase an auto but he never lacked for a ride, as the owners of autos at that time will recall.

Father O'Brien arranged for the erection of the school in 1899. During the early days the nuns occupied the upper floors of the building but the growth of the parish made it necessary to use this space for class rooms and a residence across from the school on Palmer Avenue was secured for use of the nuns. The constantly increasing congregation demanded additional church space and the present edifice was started and completed in 1907, the rectory in 1911, the hall in 1913 and the convent in 1917, all through the untiring efforts of Father O'Brien.

During these fifty years six parishes have received their territory from St. Sylvester's.

Father O'Brien died on June 3rd, 1921 but lived to witness the completion of many plans he had formulated for the well being of his parishioners. He was succeeded by the Reverend Father Thomas F. Quinn.

Father Quinn was born in Ireland, April 16, 1873. He received his primary education in St. Pius' School, Chicago. He was in the last class ordained by the venerable and beloved Archbishop Feehan, receiving Holy Orders at Holy Name Cathedral on Saturday, June 24th, 1899, was appointed Assistant at St. Catharine's, Austin, being there two years. His next appointment was as Assistant to The Rt. Rev. Bishop Muldoon at St. Charles' Church remaining there until he was made Pastor of Everett and Deerfield, Ill., thence to St. Mary's, Joliet and came to St. Sylvester's on June 26th, 1921.

Father Quinn's pastorate at St. Sylvester's has been one of praiseworthy activity in every direction and it was well fitting that on April 29th, 1928 he should have conferred on him the title of Monsignor. His chief concern has been the spiritual welfare of this vast parish. Socially he has lent his interest and encouragement to every progressive and uplifting enterprise.

A new foundation was needed for the Church shortly after his coming and was immediately installed. A second stairway was added to the school for safety and convenience of the children. A few years later a new foundation was placed under the School. Then the work of beautifying the church was begun and closed with the completion and consecration of the marble altars. The growth of the parish was such that an extra Mass was added and the mezzanine floor built to accommodate the people.

The material progress of this parish of St. Sylvester is but a reflex of its spiritual welfare; various societies, school and other agencies have all contributed their bit. Socially the parish has always been marked for the friendly and homelike spirit found among its members.

May we not with pardonable pride, rejoice in the gratifying achievements of St. Sylvester Parish, both spiritually and materially accomplished, the love of God and the salvation of mankind. And let us now pause a moment in loving remembrance of those pastors and pioneer parishioners of blessed memory who had worked unselfishly toward bringing our parish to the high place it has taken among the other parishes of the city. You who have left the confines of St. Sylvester's but still call it "your parish", are welcome today. To us who have remained, we indeed will keep St. Sylvester's close to our hearts and continue to give our best efforts for its success. And lastly, to you our beloved pastor, devoted father of his flock—our dear Monsignor, may your time among us be long, to carry on the magnificent work which you have accomplished in St. Sylvester Parish.
