



"BUILD A MONUMENT" WALKS

A new series of Saturday walks in the Nipomo Dunes has started, offering hikers the chance to contribute to a monument honoring the family that has made one of the area's most beautiful sites available to the public: Coreopsis Hill near Oso Flaco Lake.

Kathleen Goddard Jones, the "first lady of the dunes" is leading "rock hikes" sponsored by the Santa Lucia Chapter of the Sierra Club and the San Luis Obispo County Chapter of the California Native Plant Society.

Participants are invited to bring a stone, of any size, to contribute to the project of building a modest monument on Coreopsis Hill. When enough stones are collected a plaque will be affixed in appreciation of the Enos family.

- Walks Every Saturday start 10 A.M to about 1 or 2 P.M.
- Meet at Osos Flaco Lake parking lot, the cars will then drive to a location a mile away (so there won't be the \$4 parking lot fee)
- Bring water or beverages, a lunch, a sun hat and a jacket. Children, any age, welcome.
- The Hike mostly level and easy.
