


4. Pipeline Julius hearings. . . it was discussed that this pipeline will disturb much acreage with mitigation practically impossible. President Liz asked around the Board who would attend the hearings of the SLO County Planning Department on this phase of the San Miguel Project. The hearings are presently expected to be held in late October. Liz may not yet be back from New York at that time.  
Jack Dougherty said he expected to participate in the hearings. Others could not at this time be definite.
5. Postcards depicting Nipomo Dunes landscape were discussed by Bill Denneen. President Liz appointed a Postcard Committee, consisting of Bill Denneen and Jack Dougherty, . . . and requested that they report their suggestions at the November 2nd meeting.
6. Guide to the Dunes: Bill Denneen posed the question, is it timely now for putting together a DUNES GUIDE. The consensus of those present was that the time is not yet right for this.
