However, of course the entire Sierra Club usually marshals its forces in a unified way in any cause which the national Club champions. So it is an unhappy situation that there actually is some friction locally about the "saving of the Dunes". Nevertheless, I constantly try to include the Santa Lucia Group in the total effort of the campaign. It was right to state that the outing on June 27 was a Group outing (and one in a series of Group outings), but as I said above - in order to reduce friction which appeared, from our Chairman, Mr. Wilson, I have left the Group name out of enclosed report.

I like your page, The Family Page, and always read it. I very much like all your handling of the Sierra Club news.

I am not sure whether Doreen Case is still on vacation or not; but anyway, I have sent her a carbon copy of the enclosed news report.
