private property, with lakes

buildings have been destroyed.

Bridges, duck blinds. A man
dressed in Japanese women's kimono
& with a mask on his face was
taking pictures! A really lovely
day with sun & breezes - much
like S.F. winds. To the Giza

to a paper store + to a department store where we had tea + parted Mari to her home + we to my Asia Center. Made reservation for my return on May 12 from Korea. To bed about 9 - couldn't keep my eyes open.

Thursday 4/19/84 Raining - cold!
Masako called for me at 8:40 + off to the Dr. She to have x-rays + x-ray for her back. Had a fall while in Hawaii, Bandaged removed + head soaked in medicated warm water, then new bandage. Bought tickets for Kyoto for to-morrow. Masako is on her way to Osaka so we will travel together. It was raining when I got up + outside Juyama station - Found my way to Asia Center after a false start, but soaking wet.

Note from Maurice that he would
call at 1 p.m. Changed clothes
had a good warm lunch + nap.
Maurice came about 2 + we
plan for to-morrow to leave
for Kyoto. Train leaves at 10:12.
It's too cold + raining so will
not go out but pack for to-morrow.
Friday 4/20/84

We are to meet Masako on train.
Maurice breakfast at Asia Center
then by taxi to Tokyo station.
There he parked me in a corner
+ dashed off to a hotel just one
station away where he had spent
one night + forgotten the medication
for his skin. There was 45 min before
10:12 train time. After half an hour
I began to worry. At 10 I carried
the luggage by 2 trips near to
escalator to track ^{*}15 - bullet train.
Then 2 trips up escalator so as to

near train. Masako saw me
& helped me on to train. Still
no Maurice. I was furious!
But he made it. Masako
had bought box lunches & juice.
Nice train ride mostly veg,
gardens in flat area then
small hills. Arrived in
Kyoto at 1:15. taxi to Hotel,
Karasuma Kyoto Hotel.
Very nice. More luxurious
than Asia Center also more
expansive. Weary, Maurice
talks so much - like a teacher.
Put on Kimono - nap - Maurice
off to bank & to check into
his Hostel. Left his luggage
& will pick it up later.
Made a cup of tea & snacks.
Will call Donald in morning.
Tried to stay awake until 9 PM
but couldn't so to bed 8:30 - Don

called at 10:30 pm.!! They are too busy - overwhelmed so I won't see them Sunday. Oka-San very old & weak - may not be able to see him. Made tea - read & to bed at midnight. So warm I don't know how to regulate the air condisioner.

Sat., April 21 st

Awake at 5:15 made tea shower & dressed ready for breakfast at 7 PM. Many Australians. Will get some bandage from Drug store in Building when it opens & change bandage. Asked if there were messages for me at desk. None. A few minutes after arrival in room tele-call from Fuji Paper they would like to meet with me. Can I go to Tohushima? Tomorrow

5 hotels called, Kyoto Grand, Kyoto Town
mine was KARASUMA Kyoto Hotel!

on Monday! Wow! So glad they
called + not me. Young man
Am. I think did the talking +
arrangements for flight Mon.
Morn #703. Hope Maurice
will come along.

Flea market at Temple Jo
by underground + bus.

Mobs of people + hundreds
of stands, plants, food, natural
tools, candy, junk + antiques.

Spent 2 1/2 hours there. Maurice
bought a brocade obi, hosi + shirt.

I bought a hoovi 500 yen ea. 4⁰⁰!

Returned by taxi but taxi driver
drove us to the wrong Kyoto
Hotel. Maurice was furious!

Cup of tea + planned for Monday
when we leave for Korea.

Impossible to go to Tokushima
as Wesley Sen had planned
for Mr. Fujimori. Called at 7 P.M.

Talked to Wesley (we are on first names)
said I could not make it to the Mill
on Monday. Could this meeting be in
May 8 to 11 on our return from Korea?
Yes, but he would not be there to
interpret & it would be difficult to
communicate. He is a researcher
for Tapa cloth from Honolulu, making
Tapa from woshi and he is returning
on the 22nd. After quiring of what
I wanted & his explanations, there
is no need for me to go thru!

Sunday April 22.

Awake at 3:30 with snuffle. at 4:30
showered & washed hair. read until

Easter Sunday April 22

3:30 AM awake! (refettin)

Good breakfast, omelet, sausage,

tomato juice, toast, shredded french fries

Will wait for Don's call. Hope

Maurice will call so I can tell

him not to worry about Pinguini

He did not call. Don did.

They will be here 12:30. You you

& he take me to a small restaurant

with special pickle dishes, raw

fish, bamboo shoots & off course rice

soup - tea. We then went to the

Botanical Gardens. A very unique

place, Cherry trees. Camellias of all

colors. flowers, trees, fountain &

People, big & little. Rather cold.

Parting & tea/coffee then back to

Hotel as Don has papers to correct

before to-morrow. Only the youngest

son is at home now. Nagay is in

College in Mass. U.S.B. Peter in

college here (Japan).

To Osaka for plane to Seoul

Monday April 23

Maurice arrived at 8 AM. I had had breakfast, settled my bill & all packed. We left by taxi for office of JAL office to catch Airport Bus. We had just missed one & had to wait an hour on sidewalk. Young girl from JAL come & invited us to wait inside, seated. Very sweet of her. Bus stops several times at Hotels & certain stops etc. Plenty of time ~~Plane~~ leaves at 2 so we wandered around & looked at shop windows etc. Box lunch on Plane, Ride 1 1/2 from Osaka to Seoul, Bus ride had been over an hour. Pick up luggage, Customs. A French woman was in trouble. Her flight had not been confirmed & there was no seat for her. Daughter in Osaka with Japanese boyfriend. Young customs asked me to help her as I spoke a little French. Very hard to explain to her, she very upset.

First of twin beds - Ambassador Hotel
Seoul, Korea

Was told to go to JAL office, Maurice

4:30 we had to leave her to wait

is garish. Good beds, big bath room
older fashion. Bath room in Karasuma
Kyototatel had one piece molded
tub, wash basin & floor all in one piece.
Free drinks at Fresh Strawberry fest.
Live music - piano. After a shower
decided I was too tired to dress
for dinner - not hungry. So Maurice
