slowly add diluted cornstarch to thicken
add raisins.

Pour in to pie crust - ~~cook~~ bake.

450° 10 min 375 30 min

1 boiled chicken, deboned & skinned
cut into small pcs. Add peas, carrots

with 2 tb of flour dissolved in cold water
cook 15-30 minutes. Make pie crust
& small pie plate. Lower crust fill
with chicken & cover with crust.
Freeze - heat when need.

Alternatives To Gold Tooling by Slim Evnard

line with folder
wet with fine brush - lightly
re define with folder
heat tool - wet sponge, fingers, hold with hand
tool is now ready.
hold tool the same direction also work in same
direction.

After two tracing with warm tool, line is
now ready for blind tooling, gold or paint
if a darker line is wanted, ~~for~~ dampen
a tool immediately.

Acrylic.
Color diluted in water to resemble ink
ruling pen should be width of line
fill with brush + test first on paper then in line
a risk to do it twice.

Aluma tanned goat + calf.

Box calf is water proofed

stenciling knife
cutting the mylar.
