Bevel edges - lap $3/8$ " attach ^{with} paste of
gelatin + acetic acid to cover 24 hrs.
dry under weight but let it set up first 1 hr.
then press, not hard but increase.

Clean Vellum - warm milks + wad of cotton
small circular motion (not on cooling or letting)
go over with moistened cloth - castor oil -
rub well with hands.
