

Significance (continued)

In the opinion of the State Historic Preservation Office, the Alexander State Forest Headquarters Building is the primary resource associated with state forestry conservation efforts in the early twentieth century. Firstly, it is the only structure left in the Alexander State Forest dating back to the time when the facility was being created and developed. Secondly, it was the center of administration for the forest, and the forest itself was the centerpiece of the conservation effort. Finally, conservation activities which took place outside the state forest (reforestation contracts, technical help, etc.) are the type which would not have left tangible cultural resources.
