In Photo 4, we see that the previous log has been loaded, and the crew is preparing to load the next log. The loader required a crew of four men an operator, fireman, and two men on the log tongs, and all had to be able to work together almost instinctively to work safely.

In our enlargement of photo 4, we see that the men are doing something to the tracks and that they are accompanied by one of the D-7 cats that the

museum now has in the finished lumber shed. Whatever they are doing, it is still in progress.
