The only other known RR&G pass is this, one of two found in the desk in the roundhouse foreman's office at Long Leaf while cleaning up for the museum. Printed during WW2 they were never issued.

This one also would have gotten you a ride in the RR&G caboose out to Kurthwood and back, Monday, Wednesday or Friday. Like the one above, it is between all stations, so you could also have ridden Tuesday, Thursday or Saturday from Long Leaf to Lecompte even though the Official Guide said this was Freight Only.

CONDITIONS

This Pass is not transferable, and is void if presented by any other than the person named, or if any alteration, addition or erasure is made upon it.
