

In our last photo from this series, we can see that in the time that it took the ground crew to secure the load with the chains and then load one or two smaller logs on top, that the train has come back, bringing with it a flat car with another bulldozer, this one with a blade.

The crew is still loading smaller logs on top of the larger ones, and the presence of the train indicates that they will soon start moving the log cars under the loader for more log loading.

Obviously, the photographer did not find a wood burning, cabbage stack locomotive of sufficient interest for him to take a photo of it, or the person that copied these photos did not.

From our vantage point of 73 years later, we can only wish that there is one more photo out there somewhere with the locomotive in it.
