



This lock, with its checkered front and back, and the cast RR&G in the key cover is the only known example.

Made by the Miller Lock Company of Philadelphia, it is believed to be a car lock. Called a type 1 lock, to separate it from the other types of RR&G locks, it uses the same key as the type 2 locks as well.

This lock is in the Frank Kell collection in Portland, Oregon
