



Skidders for operating with overhead trolley cable are particularly adapted for use in mountainous and rough country or in cypress swamps where the conditions do not permit successful ground skidding.

Logging conditions which require the cableway system are almost as great in variety as the



number of operations. To meet these conditions the Clyde regular line covers several styles and numerous combinations as well as different sizes of engines, so that some size and combination of practically standard design may be found to fit most circumstances or requirements.

The quick moving feature embodied in Clyde logging equipment has received particular attention in designing Clyde Cableway machines. The result is machinery which makes the cableway logging system cheaper than ever before, and possible to log economically under conditions that were heretofore difficult to overcome, if not actually insurmountable.

These machines embody such a variety of Clyde improvements over the old methods of cableway logging as to revolutionize this phase of skidding practice.
