Patterson according to his statement is a right of way cutter for the company, came here with the company, is on a 24 cents per hour rating, treated fine, worked fairly and was well satisfied.

Talbert claims to be employed at the company's general office as a porter, and though he gave no pay rating received, he claims to have been with the company many years, was treated well, and was well satisfied.

Short claims to be and engineer and fireman helper around the plant. That he was on a pay rating of 24 cents per hour, was treated well, worked fairly and was well satisfied.
