

## Urania Forest Plots

Plots C-2 and C-3 were unfenced (until 1922) to note principally the effects from hogs and cattle grazing. The hogs uprooted all the seedlings before they were three years old. Cattle grazing was not detrimental. From these plots we learned that young Long Leaf Pine had great fire resisting qualities, but would eventually succumb; that it could not resist the hogs; that young Short Leaf Pine and Loblolly Pine could not survive a fire. Does forestry pay? Look at the protected plot and you have the answer.

### Urania, John M. Parker Plot No. 9-38 acres.

Fenced August 1916-3000 Long Leaf Pine seedlings one to six years old. Cattle are pastured in the plot--cattle grazing on land where fires are prevented improves the grasses and reduces the fire hazard. This is already a show plot on Pelican Highway and a monument to a Governor who does things.

### Urania Plot No. 7-2500 acres-fenced.

On East side of Pelican Highway. See the seed trees and note the vigorous young seedlings three to seven years old, how they completely occupy every vacant space. Cattle, elk and deer roam in this enclosure. Is your vision keen enough to see a regenerated forest? Can you imagine its appearance 20 years hence? Does forestry pay? Look closely and you will answer Yes.
