



DOLPHIN CLUB SWIMMERS TO SPAN RACCOON STRAITS

Sixty members of the Dolphin Swimming and Boating Club of San Francisco will visit Tiburon the hard way, this coming Saturday, when they swim the Raccoon Straits.

Diving from the Sea Scout Boat, Sea Horse, at 10 a.m., the members will paddle the five-eights mile channel from Angel Island and land on the Tiburon shore.

Jim Small, ex-University of California swim champ is the favorite in the 10th annual swim.

The last time the Dolphins visited Tiburon was in April when they rowed over in their 75 year-old six-oared barge, the John Wieland.

Roland Demarais of Tiburon will chairman the luncheon which will be held at the Corinthian Yacht Club for members and their guests after the swim.

The swim is considered a good test for the club's annual Golden Gate Swim slated for September 23.
