Our Senior single entry, Clyde Mineau, rowed a fine race losing by a few lengths to take second place. D. Garrassino, Junior singles did well for his first championship race.

We are preparing now for the closing Regatta of the Season to be held in the Aquatic Park on Columbus Day.

According to present arrangements the 1937 P.A.A.O. Championship Regatta will be held in Long Beach, so if you boys want to make the trip you better start practicing now.

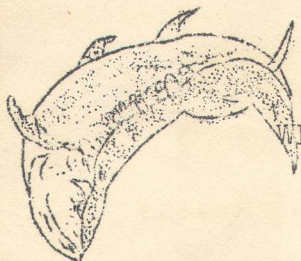

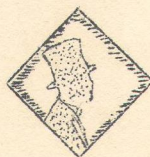

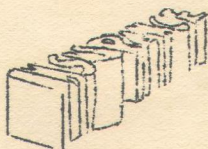

"WATER POLO"

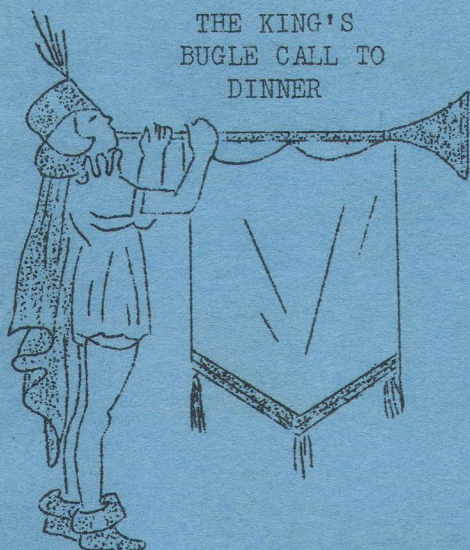
