bargained and sold to the said Daniel
Martin in fee simple the undivided one
third part of lot number seven in front

upon Niagara River in the Township of

Bertie in said District of Niagara and one

third of lot number seven in the second concession

in the said Township of Bertie subject to such

charges and encumbrances as are contained in

the will of the late Henry Putnam deceased

and also his heirs granted the said Daniel

Martin in fee simple the next moiety or

half part of the following tract of land (that

is to say) That certain tract piece or parcel

of land situated lying and being in the Town
