" the aforesaid Six hundred acres thence South
" $78\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}30''$ West to the town line of Burford
" thence following the said Town line of
" Burford Southward till it intersects the
" aforesaid Marsh thence following the winding
" and turning of the said Marsh an Eastwardly
" course to the place of beginning to contain
" six hundred acres by bounding the whole of
" one side of said land upon the said Marsh."
