Enclosed you have – three Ten dollar – and three Four dollar Bills on the Gore Banke [sic] with Two shillings silver makg [sic] together £10.12 being the second installment due on Lot number twelve I the seventh Concefsion [sic] of the Township of Sandwich a clergy reserve = sold at Public sale to Charles Cole who will feel obliged by your transmitting him a receipt for the sum at your earliest convenience and for whom [unknown word]
