My dear Sir

I had the pleasure 3 days ago to receive your letter of the 23d [unknown word] on the subject of your [unknown word] transaction with the Montreal Bank, and I immediately called upon Mr Scobie to whom I related the facts as nearly as I could recollect he however desired me to put the matter I writing which I did yesterday – and now [unknown word] to enclose a copy thereof.

a [sic] report has just reached [unknown word] that cabinet have all resigned and that there is to be a new election forthwith.

I hope that your Son likes Kingston. What do say to his remaining there the winter – as sending down another
