yours of the 26th [?] I duly received containing a check on the Bank o [sic] Upper Canada for £45.3.1 ¼ and pay Taxes on certain [?] in this District (a schedule of which I have also received) belonging to the Canada Company and for which you require a "[atetailea?] receipt".

In reply these to I beg to say, that the acts 59th Geo 3rd and 9 Geo 4th [cap?] 3 by which you made your calculations of the amount of Taxes due, have been superceded [sic?] by Bylaw No. 1 and 42 if the Municipal Council of this District, and also that I have furnished K. Wedder Esquire with a detailed acct. showing the several amounts due on the lots respectively [?] to the above By Laws. Therefore as the amount of your [smudged underneath] check is [?] By £32.4.3 to cover the Real amount of Taxes due, I shall wait a sufficient time in order to give W. Wedder an opportunity of advising me whether I am to place the amount received to the Credit of the [?] as far as it will go, or wait for the balance of money Required to pay up the whole, of which you will please apprise M. Wedder
