Envelope

Upper corner left:

A postmark stamped with an outer and inner circle in black ink. Between the inner and outer circle the word YORK in the top, (illegible) in the bottom. In the centre of the inner circle, DEC 1856. Below the post mark in vertical position, in direction of the circular post mark, another post mark in form of an arrow, in red ink.

In the center and slightly tilted to the right: the word **PAID**, in brown/ochre ink and post market.

To the right of the **paid** word, vertically, post marked, brown/ochre ink, large size: the number **3**
