Know ye, that reposing Trust and confidence in the loyalty, integrity and ability of you the said James Edward Small We have assigned constituted and appointed and by these Presents do assign, constitute and appoint you the said James Edward Small to be Our Solicitor General in and for that part of the Province of Canada, formerly known as Upper Canada, in the room and place of Henry Sherwood Esquire -----To have hold, and enjoy the said Office unto you the said James Edward Small for and during Our Pleasure, and your residence within Our said Province; together with all and singular the rights, fees, profits, privileges and advantages thereunto belonging and appertaining in as full and ample a manner as any Solicitor General of Our said Province, formerly Upper Canada, hath held and enjoyed the same. Provided always that you the said James Edward Small do execute the said Office in person except in sickness or incapacity-----
