To the Honorable James Edward Small, Judge of the London District Court, and to all to whom  
these Presents shall come, \_\_\_\_\_

Know Ye what We have assigned you the said James Edward Small  
Our Justice to keep the Peace in in and through Our District of London of Our said Province of  
Canada; hereby associating you for that purpose with Our Justices already appointed by Us in  
and for the said District, and hereby fully and affectionally giving and granting unto you all and  
very the like powers and authorities given and granted and by Our Royal Commission to Our  
Justice as aforesaid therein named, and as fully and affectionally to all intent and purpose as if  
the said powers and authorities were herein and hereby particularly mentioned and expressed.  
And we do command all and every Our Justices named in Our said Commission for our  
aforesaid District to receive you as their Associate and further we do hereby command our  
sheriff of our said District and all constables and other Peace officers in our aforesaid District  
and all others our liege subjects therein to pay due obedience to you as Our Justice by the  
Presents assigned. \_\_\_\_\_

In Testimony thereof We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal  
of Our said Province to be hereunto affixed. Witness Our Right Trusty and Right Well. Beloved  
Cousin James Earl of Elgin and Kincardine Knight of the most ancient and most Noble Order of  
the Thistle Governor General of British North America and Captain General and Governor in  
Chief in and over Our Provinces of Canada, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick and the Island of Prince  
Edward and Vice Admiral of the same Vc\_\_Vc\_\_Vc\_\_ at Toronto, in our Province of Canada, this  
fifteenth day of November in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty nine,  
and in the thirteenth year of our reign. \_\_\_\_\_
